- A piece of ground adjoining a house, in which grass, flowers, and shrubs may be grown.
- The flowers or vegetables or fruits or herbs that are cultivated in a garden.
- A large public hall.
- A plot of ground where plants are cultivated.
- A yard or lawn adjoining a house.
- A street or square.






Synonyms of "Garden" as a noun (2 Words)

Associations of "Garden" (30 Words)

<u>arboreal</u>	Living in trees. Arboreal apes.
<u>arboretum</u>	A facility where trees and shrubs are cultivated for exhibition.
aster	A plant of a large genus that includes the Michaelmas daisy, typically having purple or pink rayed flowers.
azalea	Any of numerous ornamental shrubs grown for their showy flowers of various colors.
botanical	Of or relating to plants or botany. Botanical garden.
botany	The branch of biology that studies plants. The botany of China.
conservatory	A greenhouse in which plants are arranged in a pleasing manner. <i>Keep plant cuttings in a frost free conservatory or greenhouse.</i>



dendroid	(of a plant, marine invertebrate, or structure) tree-shaped; branching.
efflorescence	Rapid growth or development. <i>Efflorescence</i> stains on the walls.
entomology	The branch of zoology concerned with the study of insects.
flora	A book or other work detailing the plants of a particular region or habitat. <i>Britain s native flora</i> .
flower	A flower together with its stalk picked for use as a decoration. A bunch of flower s.
flowering	Producing flowers at a specified time or of a specified type. <i>Flowering</i> dogwood.
gardening	The activity of tending and cultivating a garden, especially as a pastime. <i>Her love of gardening</i> .
grass	Cover with grass. Anglers grass ed 294 trout.
grove	A small growth of trees without underbrush. An olive grove .
herbaceous	Denoting or relating to herbs (in the botanical sense).
herbarium	A room or building housing a herbarium.
horticultural	Of or relating to the cultivation of plants. <i>The horticultural industry.</i>
horticulture	The art or practice of garden cultivation and management. <i>Maize and manioc</i> horticulture .
hothouse	An environment that encourages rapid growth or development, especially in a stifling or intense way. The hothouse atmosphere of the college.
microbiology	The branch of science that deals with microorganisms.
ornithology	The branch of zoology that studies birds.
patio	A paved outdoor area adjoining a house. A patio table and chairs.
plant	Place a plant in the ground out of doors so it can grow especially after growing it from seed in an indoor environment. The garden is plant ed with herbs.
<u>plantation</u>	An estate where cash crops are grown on a large scale (especially in tropical areas. New conifer plantations .
rooftop	The top of a (usually flat) roof. A rooftop garden.
