## Associations of "Geared" (30 Words)

<b>auto</b>	A motor vehicle with four wheels; usually propelled by an internal combustion engine. <i>The <b>auto</b> industry.</i>
<b>automobile</b>	Travel in an automobile.
<b>bus</b>	Send or move around by bus. <i>He always rode the <b>bus</b> to work.</i>
<b>car</b>	A railway carriage. <i>They took a cable <b>car</b> to the top of the mountain.</i>
<b>cog</b>	Each of the projections on a cog. <i>The <b>cogs</b> and springs of a watch.</i>
<b>conveyor</b>	A conveyor belt. <i>A <b>conveyor</b> of information.</i>
<b>crane</b>	Move a heavy object with a crane. <i>She <b>craned</b> her neck to see past me.</i>
<b>cyclist</b>	A person who rides a bicycle.
<a href="#">driver</a>	A golfer who hits the golf ball with a driver. <i>A taxi <b>driver</b>.</i>
<b>electric</b>	Affected by emotion as if by electricity thrilling. <i><b>Electric</b> bass guitar.</i>
<b>electrify</b>	Charge (a conductor) with electricity. <i>After locking the farm gate I had switched on the power to <b>electrify</b> the fence.</i>
<b>hitch</b>	An act of hitch hiking. <i>He returned to where he had <b>hitched</b> his horse.</i>
<b>kit</b>	A set of all the parts needed to assemble something. <i>A fox <b>kit</b>.</i>

<b>limousine</b>	Large luxurious car; usually driven by a chauffeur. <i>The Prince was whisked away in a black <b>limousine</b>.</i>
<b>motorist</b>	The driver of a car.
<b><u>paraphernalia</u></b>	Miscellaneous articles, especially the equipment needed for a particular activity. <i>The rituals and <b>paraphernalia</b> of government.</i>
<b><u>ride</u></b>	A mechanical device that you ride for amusement or excitement. <i>Investors have had a bumpy <b>ride</b>.</i>
<b>sprocket</b>	A wheel with sprockets.
<b>streetcar</b>	A tram.
<b>taxi</b>	A boat or other means of transportation used in the same way as a taxi. <i>He <b>taxied</b> the plane to the very end of the airstrip.</i>
<b>tool</b>	Furnish with tools. <i>We <b>tooled</b> down the street.</i>
<b><u>train</u></b>	Undergo training or instruction in preparation for a particular role function or profession. <i>A camel <b>train</b>.</i>
<b>tram</b>	Travel by tram. <i>A <b>tramcar</b> carries coal out of a coal mine.</i>
<b>transporter</b>	(in science fiction) a device that conveys people or things instantaneously from one place to another.
<b><u>truck</u></b>	Convey by truck. <i><b>Truck</b> fresh vegetables across the mountains.</i>
<b>trucker</b>	Someone who drives a truck as an occupation.
<b>used</b>	Having already been used. <i>Scrawling on the back of a <b>used</b> envelope.</i>
<b><u>wagon</u></b>	A light horse-drawn vehicle, especially a covered one used by early settlers in North America and elsewhere. <i>A timber <b>wagon</b>.</i>
<b>wheel</b>	A large wheel used as an instrument of punishment or torture especially by binding someone to it and breaking their limbs. <i>Robert <b>wheeled</b> round to see the face of Mr Mafouz.</i>
