Associations of "Geared" (30 Words)

auto	A motor vehicle with four wheels; usually propelled by an internal combustion engine. <i>The auto industry.</i>
automobile	Travel in an automobile.
bus	Send or move around by bus. <i>He always rode the bus to work.</i>
car	A railway carriage. <i>They took a cable car to the top of the mountain.</i>
cog	Each of the projections on a cog. <i>The cogs and springs of a watch.</i>
conveyor	A conveyor belt. <i>A conveyor of information.</i>
crane	Move a heavy object with a crane. <i>She craned her neck to see past me.</i>
cyclist	A person who rides a bicycle.
<u>driver</u>	A golfer who hits the golf ball with a driver. <i>A taxi driver.</i>
electric	Affected by emotion as if by electricity thrilling. <i>Electric bass guitar.</i>
electrify	Charge (a conductor) with electricity. <i>After locking the farm gate I had switched on the power to electrify the fence.</i>
hitch	An act of hitch hiking. <i>He returned to where he had hitched his horse.</i>
kit	A set of all the parts needed to assemble something. <i>A fox kit.</i>

limousine	Large luxurious car; usually driven by a chauffeur. <i>The Prince was whisked away in a black limousine.</i>
motorist	The driver of a car.
<u>paraphernalia</u>	Miscellaneous articles, especially the equipment needed for a particular activity. <i>The rituals and paraphernalia of government.</i>
<u>ride</u>	A mechanical device that you ride for amusement or excitement. <i>Investors have had a bumpy ride.</i>
sprocket	A wheel with sprockets.
streetcar	A tram.
taxi	A boat or other means of transportation used in the same way as a taxi. <i>He taxied the plane to the very end of the airstrip.</i>
tool	Furnish with tools. <i>We tooled down the street.</i>
<u>train</u>	Undergo training or instruction in preparation for a particular role function or profession. <i>A camel train.</i>
tram	Travel by tram. <i>A tramcar carries coal out of a coal mine.</i>
transporter	(in science fiction) a device that conveys people or things instantaneously from one place to another.
<u>truck</u>	Convey by truck. <i>Truck fresh vegetables across the mountains.</i>
trucker	Someone who drives a truck as an occupation.
used	Having already been used. <i>Scrawling on the back of a used envelope.</i>
<u>wagon</u>	A light horse-drawn vehicle, especially a covered one used by early settlers in North America and elsewhere. <i>A timber wagon.</i>
wheel	A large wheel used as an instrument of punishment or torture especially by binding someone to it and breaking their limbs. <i>Robert wheeled round to see the face of Mr Mafouz.</i>
