## Associations of "Geared towards" (30 Words)

<b>auto</b>	A motor vehicle with four wheels; usually propelled by an internal combustion engine. <i>The <b>auto</b> industry.</i>
<b>automobile</b>	Travel in an automobile.
<b>bus</b>	The topology of a network whose components are connected by a busbar. <i>He always rode the <b>bus</b> to work.</i>
<b>car</b>	The compartment that is suspended from an airship and that carries personnel and the cargo and the power plant. <i>They took a cable <b>car</b> to the top of the mountain.</i>
<b>cog</b>	Join pieces of wood with cogs. <i>The <b>cogs</b> and springs of a watch.</i>
<b>conveyor</b>	A conveyor belt. <i>A <b>conveyor</b> of information.</i>
<b>crane</b>	Move a heavy object with a crane. <i>She <b>craned</b> forward to look more clearly.</i>
<b>cyclist</b>	A person who rides a bicycle.
<a href="#"><u>driver</u></a>	A golfer who hits the golf ball with a driver. <i>The hope of achieving such monopolies becomes the main <b>driver</b> of investment.</i>
<b>electric</b>	Using or providing or producing or transmitting or operated by electricity. <i>Gave an <b>electric</b> reading of the play.</i>
<b>electrify</b>	Equip for use with electricity. <i>After locking the farm gate I had switched on the power to <b>electrify</b> the fence.</i>
<b>hitch</b>	Obtain a lift by hitch hiking. <i><b>Hitch</b> the trailer to the car.</i>

<b>kit</b>	A case for containing a set of articles. <i>An aircraft <b>kit</b>.</i>
<b>limousine</b>	Large luxurious car; usually driven by a chauffeur. <i>The Prince was whisked away in a black <b>limousine</b>.</i>
<b>motorist</b>	Someone who drives (or travels in) an automobile.
<b><u>paraphernalia</u></b>	Miscellaneous articles, especially the equipment needed for a particular activity. <i>Drills saws and other <b>paraphernalia</b> necessary for home improvements.</i>
<b><u>ride</u></b>	A mechanical device that you ride for amusement or excitement. <i>When two lithospheric plates collide one tends to <b>ride</b> over the other.</i>
<b>sprocket</b>	A wheel with sprockets.
<b>streetcar</b>	A tram.
<b>taxi</b>	Of a pilot cause an aircraft to taxi. <i>I ll take a <b>taxi</b> from the air terminal.</i>
<b>tool</b>	A distinct design in the tooling of a book. <i>Science has given us new <b>tools</b> to fight disease.</i>
<b><u>train</u></b>	Create by training and teaching. <i>The fool got his tie caught in the gear<b>train</b>.</i>
<b>tram</b>	Travel by tram. <i>A <b>tramcar</b> carries coal out of a coal mine.</i>
<b>transporter</b>	A person or thing that transports something.
<b><u>truck</u></b>	Drive a truck. <i>Private contractors were <b>trucking</b> for Denali.</i>
<b>trucker</b>	A long-distance lorry driver.
<b>used</b>	Having already been used. <i>Scrawling on the back of a <b>used</b> envelope.</i>
<b><u>wagon</u></b>	A child's four-wheeled toy cart sometimes used for coasting. <i>A milk <b>wagon</b>.</i>
<b>wheel</b>	A large wheel used as an instrument of punishment or torture especially by binding someone to it and breaking their limbs. <i>The tea trolley was <b>wheeled</b> out.</i>
