Present Participle	gelatinating
Past Participle	gelatinated

# **Conjugate Gelatinate**

## **Gelatinate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>gelatinate</b>	We <b>gelatinate</b>
You <b>gelatinate</b>	You <b>gelatinate</b>
He/She/It gelatinates	They <b>gelatinate</b>

## **Gelatinate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am gelatinating	We are gelatinating
You <b>are gelatinating</b>	You <b>are gelatinating</b>
He/She/It is gelatinating	They are gelatinating

### **Gelatinate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have gelatinated	We have gelatinated
You <b>have gelatinated</b>	You have gelatinated
He/She/It has gelatinated	They have gelatinated

## **Gelatinate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been gelatinating	We have been gelatinating
You <b>have been gelatinating</b>	You <b>have been gelatinating</b>
He/She/It has been gelatinating	They have been gelatinating

## **Gelatinate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I gelatinated	We <b>gelatinated</b>
You <b>gelatinated</b>	You <b>gelatinated</b>
He/She/It gelatinated	They <b>gelatinated</b>

#### **Gelatinate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was gelatinating	We were gelatinating
You <b>were gelatinating</b>	You <b>were gelatinating</b>
He/She/It was gelatinating	They were gelatinating

#### **Gelatinate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had gelatinated	We had gelatinated
You had gelatinated	You had gelatinated
He/She/It had gelatinated	They had gelatinated

### **Gelatinate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been gelatinating	We had been gelatinating
You <b>had been gelatinating</b>	You <b>had been gelatinating</b>
He/She/It had been gelatinating	They had been gelatinating

## **Gelatinate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will gelatinate	We <b>will gelatinate</b>
You <b>will gelatinate</b>	You <b>will gelatinate</b>
He/She/It will gelatinate	They will gelatinate

## **Gelatinate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be gelatinating	We will be gelatinating
You <b>will be gelatinating</b>	You will be gelatinating
He/She/It will be gelatinating	They will be gelatinating

## **Gelatinate in Future Perfect Tense**

## **Gelatinate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been gelatinating	We will have been gelatinating
You <b>will have been gelatinating</b>	You <b>will have been gelatinating</b>
He/She/It will have been gelatinating	They will have been gelatinating
