# **Conjugate Gern**

## Gern in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>gern</b>	We <b>gern</b>
You <b>gern</b>	You <b>gern</b>
He/She/It gerns	They gern

## Gern in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>am gerning</b>	We <b>are gerning</b>
You <b>are gerning</b>	You <b>are gerning</b>
He/She/It is gerning	They are gerning

### **Gern in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have gerned	We have gerned
You have gerned	You have gerned
He/She/It has gerned	They have gerned

### **Gern in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been gerning	We have been gerning
You <b>have been gerning</b>	You have been gerning
He/She/It has been gerning	They have been gerning

## Gern in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I gerned	We <b>gerned</b>
You <b>gerned</b>	You <b>gerned</b>
He/She/It gerned	They <b>gerned</b>

## Gern in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was gerning	We <b>were gerning</b>
You <b>were gerning</b>	You <b>were gerning</b>
He/She/It was gerning	They were gerning

### **Gern in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had gerned	We <b>had gerned</b>
You <b>had gerned</b>	You <b>had gerned</b>
He/She/It had gerned	They had gerned

## **Gern in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been gerning	We had been gerning
You <b>had been gerning</b>	You had been gerning
He/She/It had been gerning	They had been gerning

# Gern in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will gern</b>	We <b>will gern</b>
You <b>will gern</b>	You <b>will gern</b>
He/She/It will gern	They will gern

## Gern in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be gerning	We <b>will be gerning</b>
You <b>will be gerning</b>	You <b>will be gerning</b>
He/She/It will be gerning	They will be gerning

### **Gern in Future Perfect Tense**

### **Gern in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been gerning	We <b>will have been gerning</b>
You <b>will have been gerning</b>	You <b>will have been gerning</b>
He/She/It will have been gerning	They will have been gerning
