come	Come to pass arrive as in due course. I make sure my kids come first.
derive	(of a sentence in a natural language) be linked by a set of stages to (its underlying logical form). Words whose spelling derive s from Dr Johnson s incorrect etymology.
<u>earn</u>	Earn on some commercial or business transaction earn as salary or wages. This latest win earn ed them 50 000 in prize money.



expulsion	The action or process of forcing someone to leave a place. Oxytocin causes expulsion of milk from the lactating mammary gland.
fetch	The action of fetching. That brute Cullam fetch ed him a wallop.
gain	Benefit. The stock market gain ed 24 points today.
have	Have sex with archaic use. <i>Have</i> a lover.
<u>incur</u>	Receive a specified treatment (abstract. I will pay any expenses incur red.
obtain	Be prevalent, customary, or established. Adequate insurance cover is difficult to obtain .
obtainable	Capable of being obtained. <i>Customers financial details are easily</i> obtainable .
possession	The act of having and controlling property. <i>They re charged with possession</i> .
procure	Get by special effort. Food procure d for the rebels.
<u>procurement</u>	The action or occupation of acquiring military equipment and supplies. The company s procurement s from foreign firms.
purchase	Something acquired by purchase. Mr Gill spotted the manuscript at a local auction and purchase d it for 1 500.
reach	Reach a point in time or a certain state or level. She reach ed forward and yanked the curtains back.
receive	Receive a specified treatment abstract. The band will receive a 100 000 advance.
recipient	The semantic role of the animate entity that is passively involved in the happening denoted by the verb in the clause. The recipient of the Nobel Peace Prize.
<u>regain</u>	Come upon after searching; find the location of something that was missed or lost. <i>He soon regained his composure.</i>
retrieval	The operation of accessing information from the computer's memory. <i>Online information retrieval.</i>
<u>secure</u>	Make (a door or container) hard to open; fasten or lock. <i>No airport is totally secure.</i>
