phantasmal Resembling or characteristic of a phantom. *A phantasmal* presence in the room.

Something apparently sensed but having no physical reality.

phantomThe amputee s illusion of a **phantom** limb.

Lacking in substance- W.A.Butler.

shadowy Dim shadowy forms.

spectral

A spectral menacing face.

spiritual Concerned with sacred matters or religion or the church.

Spiritual tappings at a seance.

strange Not previously visited, seen, or encountered; unfamiliar or alien.

Used many **strange** words.

(of a manifestation or event) attributed to some force beyond scientific

supernatural understanding or the laws of nature.

A woman of **supernatural** beauty.

uncanny Surpassing the ordinary or normal – George Will.

His **uncanny** sense of direction.

unearthly Suggesting the operation of supernatural influences- John Galsworthy.

Unearthly love.

unnatural Not normal; not typical or usual or regular or conforming to a norm.

The artificial turf looks an **unnatural** green.

Unrealistic.

In the half light the tiny cottages seemed unreal.

weird Suggesting the operation of supernatural influences- John Galsworthy.

The three weird sisters.

wraithlike Lacking in substance.

A **wraithlike** column of smoke.
