Girlfriend as a Noun

Definitions of "Girlfriend" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “girlfriend” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Any female friend.*
- *A woman's female friend.*
- *A person's regular female companion with whom they have a romantic or sexual relationship.*
- *A girl or young woman with whom a man is romantically involved.*



Synonyms of "Girlfriend" as a noun (5 Words)

girl A girl or young woman with whom a man is romantically involved.
*A six year old **girl**.*

lady friend A woman of the peerage in Britain.

lover A person who likes or enjoys a specified thing.
*He was a great **lover** of cats.*

partner A person's partner in marriage.
*A junior **partner**.*

woman A disrespectful form of address to a woman.
*He wondered whether Billy had his **woman** with him.*



Usage Examples of "Girlfriend" as a noun

- *His girlfriend kicked him out.*
- *Mary and her girlfriend organized the party.*
- *He lives with his girlfriend.*
- *She would rather go to the cinema with a girlfriend.*



Associations of "Girlfriend" (30 Words)

beau	A man who is much concerned with his dress and appearance.
betroth	Give to in marriage. <i>In no time I shall be betrothed to Isabel.</i>
boyfriend	A man who is the lover of a man or woman. <i>A boyfriend cardigan.</i>
buff	A soft thick undyed leather from the skins of e g buffalo or oxen. <i>The driver was a buff blond named March.</i>
concubine	(in polygamous societies) a woman who lives with a man but has lower status than his wife or wives.
couple	A pair who associate with one another. <i>Resistors are used to couple the oscillators.</i>
devotee	A strong believer in a particular religion or god. <i>Devotees of Krishna.</i>
ex	A man who was formerly a certain woman's husband. <i>All his exes live in Texas.</i>
fan	A fan shaped alluvial or talus deposit at the foot of a slope. <i>He fanned himself with his hat.</i>
fiance	A man who is engaged to be married.
fiancee	A woman who is engaged to be married.
girl	A girl or young woman with whom a man is romantically involved. <i>The baby was a girl.</i>
guy	Steady or support with a guy wire or cable. <i>The Italians guyed the Tower of Pisa to prevent it from collapsing.</i>
husband	A married man; a woman's partner in marriage. <i>She and her husband are both retired.</i>
idolater	A person who worships idols.
idolatry	Extreme admiration, love, or reverence for something or someone. <i>We must not allow our idolatry of art to obscure issues of political significance.</i>
lass	A girl or young woman. <i>He married a lass from Yorkshire.</i>
lover	A person who likes or enjoys a specified thing. <i>I think she had a secret lover.</i>

maidenhood	The fact or condition of being a young, unmarried woman. <i>Most brides wear white to symbolize maidenhood.</i>
mistress	A woman loved and courted by a man. <i>A Geography mistress.</i>
moll	A gangster's female companion. <i>I'd rush the money over to his moll.</i>
outmoded	Old-fashioned. <i>An outmoded Victorian building.</i>
<u>paramour</u>	A woman's lover.
<u>pretty</u>	Make pretty or attractive. <i>A pretty little girl with an engaging grin.</i>
troth	A mutual promise to marry. <i>A token of troth.</i>
votary	A priest or priestess (or consecrated worshipper) in a non-Christian religion or cult. <i>He was a votary of John Keats.</i>
wed	Perform a marriage ceremony. <i>They wed a week after meeting.</i>
widower	A man whose wife is dead especially one who has not remarried. <i>Her new found passion has turned me into a tennis widower.</i>
<u>wife</u>	The wife of a person with a specified occupation. <i>A clergy wife.</i>
