The patriots had to **capitulate** to the enemy forces.

Give over; surrender or relinquish to the physical control of another.

certificate Authorize by certificate.

**concession** The action of conceding or granting something.

A piece of writing submitted for publication in a journal, book, etc.

credential Provide with credentials.
