Associations of "Glaringly" (30 Words)

apparent	Seeming real or true, but not necessarily so. <i>The committee investigated some apparent discrepancies.</i>
certainly	Definitely or positively (‘sure’ is sometimes used informally for ‘surely’). <i>She certainly is a hard worker.</i>
confirming	Indicating existence or presence of a suspected condition or pathogen.
conspicuous	Obvious to the eye or mind. <i>He was very thin with a conspicuous Adam s apple.</i>
dazzling	Amazingly impressive; suggestive of the flashing of lightning. <i>A dazzling smile.</i>
decidedly	Undoubtedly; undeniably. <i>He looked decidedly uncomfortable.</i>
eidetic	Of visual imagery of almost photographic accuracy. <i>An eidetic memory.</i>
evident	Clearly revealed to the mind or the senses or judgment. <i>She ate the biscuits with evident enjoyment.</i>
expressly	For a specific purpose; solely. <i>The house was expressly built for entertaining.</i>
faintly	In a faint manner; indistinctly. <i>His faintly ridiculous air.</i>
flagrant	(of an action considered wrong or immoral) conspicuously or obviously offensive. <i>Flagrant violation of human rights.</i>
glaring	Highly obvious or conspicuous. <i>The glaring sun.</i>
graphic	Describing nudity or sexual activity in graphic detail. <i>Graphic information such as charts and diagrams.</i>

indubitably	In a manner or to a degree that could not be doubted. <i>It was immediately and indubitably apparent that I had interrupted a scene of lovers.</i>
iridescent	Showing luminous colours that seem to change when seen from different angles. <i>An iridescent oil slick.</i>
limpid	(of a person's eyes) unclouded; clear. <i>The limpid grey eyes gazed trustfully at her.</i>
lucid	Transmitting light; able to be seen through with clarity. <i>A pellucid brook.</i>
luminous	Very bright in colour; lurid. <i>The luminous dial on his watch.</i>
obvious	Easily perceived by the senses or grasped by the mind. <i>Unemployment has been the most obvious cost of the recession.</i>
opalescent	Having a play of lustrous rainbow colors. <i>A milky opalescent or opaline luster.</i>
palpability	The quality of being perceivable by touch.
pellucid	Transparently clear; easily understandable- Robert Burton. <i>Pellucid prose.</i>
perspicuity	Clarity as a consequence of being perspicuous.
perspicuous	Transparently clear; easily understandable- Robert Burton. <i>It provides simpler and more perspicuous explanations than its rivals.</i>
unambiguous	Not open to more than one interpretation. <i>As a horror apartheid is absolutely unambiguous.</i>
undoubtedly	Without doubt; certainly. <i>It s undoubtedly very beautiful.</i>
unequivocal	Clearly defined or formulated- R.B.Taney. <i>An unequivocal promise.</i>
unmistakable	Clearly revealed to the mind or the senses or judgment. <i>The unmistakable sound of his laughter.</i>
unquestionably	In a way that cannot be disputed or doubted; without question. <i>The claim is unquestionably true.</i>
visible	Visible imports or exports. <i>A visible change of expression.</i>
