## Associations of "Glaringly" (30 Words)

<a href="#">apparent</a>	Seeming real or true, but not necessarily so. <i>The committee investigated some <b>apparent</b> discrepancies.</i>
<a href="#">certainly</a>	Definitely or positively (‘sure’ is sometimes used informally for ‘surely’). <i>She <b>certainly</b> is a hard worker.</i>
<b>confirming</b>	Indicating existence or presence of a suspected condition or pathogen.
<a href="#">conspicuous</a>	Obvious to the eye or mind. <i>He was very thin with a <b>conspicuous</b> Adam s apple.</i>
<a href="#">dazzling</a>	Amazingly impressive; suggestive of the flashing of lightning. <i>A <b>dazzling</b> smile.</i>
<b>decidedly</b>	Undoubtedly; undeniably. <i>He looked <b>decidedly</b> uncomfortable.</i>
<b>eidetic</b>	Of visual imagery of almost photographic accuracy. <i>An <b>eidetic</b> memory.</i>
<a href="#">evident</a>	Clearly revealed to the mind or the senses or judgment. <i>She ate the biscuits with <b>evident</b> enjoyment.</i>
<b>expressly</b>	For a specific purpose; solely. <i>The house was <b>expressly</b> built for entertaining.</i>
<b>faintly</b>	In a faint manner; indistinctly. <i>His <b>faintly</b> ridiculous air.</i>
<b>flagrant</b>	(of an action considered wrong or immoral) conspicuously or obviously offensive. <i><b>Flagrant</b> violation of human rights.</i>
<a href="#">glaring</a>	Highly obvious or conspicuous. <i>The <b>glaring</b> sun.</i>
<a href="#">graphic</a>	Describing nudity or sexual activity in graphic detail. <i><b>Graphic</b> information such as charts and diagrams.</i>

<b>indubitably</b>	In a manner or to a degree that could not be doubted. <i>It was immediately and <b>indubitably</b> apparent that I had interrupted a scene of lovers.</i>
<b>iridescent</b>	Showing luminous colours that seem to change when seen from different angles. <i>An <b>iridescent</b> oil slick.</i>
<b>limpid</b>	(of a person's eyes) unclouded; clear. <i>The <b>limpid</b> grey eyes gazed trustfully at her.</i>
<b>lucid</b>	Transmitting light; able to be seen through with clarity. <i>A <b>pellucid</b> brook.</i>
<b>luminous</b>	Very bright in colour; lurid. <i>The <b>luminous</b> dial on his watch.</i>
<b>obvious</b>	Easily perceived by the senses or grasped by the mind. <i>Unemployment has been the most <b>obvious</b> cost of the recession.</i>
<b>opalescent</b>	Having a play of lustrous rainbow colors. <i>A milky <b>opalescent</b> or opaline luster.</i>
<b>palpability</b>	The quality of being perceivable by touch.
<b>pellucid</b>	Transparently clear; easily understandable- Robert Burton. <i><b>Pellucid</b> prose.</i>
<b>perspicuity</b>	Clarity as a consequence of being perspicuous.
<b>perspicuous</b>	Transparently clear; easily understandable- Robert Burton. <i>It provides simpler and more <b>perspicuous</b> explanations than its rivals.</i>
<b>unambiguous</b>	Not open to more than one interpretation. <i>As a horror apartheid is absolutely <b>unambiguous</b>.</i>
<b>undoubtedly</b>	Without doubt; certainly. <i>It s <b>undoubtedly</b> very beautiful.</i>
<b>unequivocal</b>	Clearly defined or formulated- R.B.Taney. <i>An <b>unequivocal</b> promise.</i>
<b>unmistakable</b>	Clearly revealed to the mind or the senses or judgment. <i>The <b>unmistakable</b> sound of his laughter.</i>
<b>unquestionably</b>	In a way that cannot be disputed or doubted; without question. <i>The claim is <b>unquestionably</b> true.</i>
<b>visible</b>	Visible imports or exports. <i>A <b>visible</b> change of expression.</i>
