- Full of high-spirited delight.






Synonyms of "Gleeful" as an adjective (13 Words)

amused	Pleasantly occupied. We are not amused .
<u>cheerful</u>	Causing happiness by its nature or appearance. The room was painted in cheerful colours.
delighted	Greatly pleased. We were delighted to see her.
elated	Exultantly proud and joyful; in high spirits. Felt elated and excited.
<u>euphoric</u>	Exaggerated feeling of well-being or elation. A euphoric sense of freedom.
exhilarated	Made joyful. The sun and the wind on his back made him feel exhilarated happy to be alive.



<u>glad</u>	Feeling pleasure or happiness. He will be glad to carry your bags.
happy	Having a sense of trust and confidence in (a person, arrangement, or situation. Spent many happy days on the beach.
<u>joyful</u>	Feeling, expressing, or causing great pleasure and happiness. A joyful occasion.
jubilant	Full of high-spirited delight. A large number of jubilant fans ran on to the pitch.
mirthful	Full of mirth; merry or amusing. A mirthful laugh.
<u>overjoyed</u>	Extremely happy. All of them were overjoyed at my success.
<u>pleased</u>	Willing or glad to do something. We will be pleased to provide an independent appraisal.
