Synonyms of "Gleeful" as an adjective (13 Words)

- amused** Pleasantly occupied.
*We are not **amused**.*
- cheerful** Causing happiness by its nature or appearance.
*The room was painted in **cheerful** colours.*
- delighted** Greatly pleased.
*We were **delighted** to see her.*
- elated** Exultantly proud and joyful; in high spirits.
*Felt **elated** and excited.*
- euphoric** Exaggerated feeling of well-being or elation.
*A **euphoric** sense of freedom.*
- exhilarated** Made joyful.
*The sun and the wind on his back made him feel **exhilarated** happy to be alive.*

glad	Feeling pleasure or happiness. <i>He will be glad to carry your bags.</i>
happy	Having a sense of trust and confidence in (a person, arrangement, or situation). <i>Spent many happy days on the beach.</i>
joyful	Feeling, expressing, or causing great pleasure and happiness. <i>A joyful occasion.</i>
jubilant	Full of high-spirited delight. <i>A large number of jubilant fans ran on to the pitch.</i>
mirthful	Full of mirth; merry or amusing. <i>A mirthful laugh.</i>
overjoyed	Extremely happy. <i>All of them were overjoyed at my success.</i>
pleased	Willing or glad to do something. <i>We will be pleased to provide an independent appraisal.</i>
