Made joyful.

**exhilarated** The sun and the wind on his back made him feel **exhilarated** happy to be alive.

He will be **glad** to carry your bags.

jubilant Full of high-spirited delight.

A **mirthful** laugh.


**overjoyed** Extremely happy.
