## Synonyms of "Gleeful" as an adjective (13 Words)

- amused** Pleasantly occupied.  
*We are not **amused**.*
- cheerful** Causing happiness by its nature or appearance.  
*The room was painted in **cheerful** colours.*
- delighted** Greatly pleased.  
*We were **delighted** to see her.*
- elated** Exultantly proud and joyful; in high spirits.  
*Felt **elated** and excited.*
- euphoric** Exaggerated feeling of well-being or elation.  
*A **euphoric** sense of freedom.*
- exhilarated** Made joyful.  
*The sun and the wind on his back made him feel **exhilarated** happy to be alive.*

<b>glad</b>	Feeling pleasure or happiness. <i>He will be <b>glad</b> to carry your bags.</i>
<b>happy</b>	Having a sense of trust and confidence in (a person, arrangement, or situation). <i>Spent many <b>happy</b> days on the beach.</i>
<b>joyful</b>	Feeling, expressing, or causing great pleasure and happiness. <i>A <b>joyful</b> occasion.</i>
<b>jubilant</b>	Full of high-spirited delight. <i>A large number of <b>jubilant</b> fans ran on to the pitch.</i>
<b>mirthful</b>	Full of mirth; merry or amusing. <i>A <b>mirthful</b> laugh.</i>
<b>overjoyed</b>	Extremely happy. <i>All of them were <b>overjoyed</b> at my success.</i>
<b>pleased</b>	Willing or glad to do something. <i>We will be <b>pleased</b> to provide an independent appraisal.</i>
