*Saw the moon like a **shiny** dime on a deep blue velvet carpet.*

brightness	Success and happiness. <i>The brightness will linger through Wednesday.</i>
brilliance	Exceptional talent or intelligence. <i>Lapis lazuli was highly regarded for the brilliance of its colour.</i>
brilliant	A diamond of brilliant cut. <i>We had a brilliant time.</i>

brilliantly	In a very bright or dazzling way. <i>The brilliantly hued orchid.</i>
dazzling	Shining intensely. <i>A dazzling smile.</i>
glaze	Coat with a glaze. <i>The glaze of the white cups.</i>
gleaming	Bright with a steady but subdued shining. <i>Gleaming black limousines.</i>
glossy	Having a surface made smooth and glossy especially by pressing between rollers. <i>Glossy paper.</i>
iridescence	The visual property of something having a milky brightness and a play of colors from the surface.
lucent	Glowing with or giving off light. <i>The moon was lucent in the background.</i>
luminosity	The rate of emission of radiation, visible or otherwise. <i>Acrylic colours retain freshness and luminosity.</i>
luminous	Softly bright or radiant. <i>A sky luminous with stars.</i>
lustrous	Having lustre; shining. <i>Large lustrous eyes.</i>
opalescence	The visual property of something having a milky brightness and a play of colors from the surface.
opalescent	Showing many small points of shifting colour against a pale or dark ground. <i>An opalescent sky.</i>
polish	Improve or perfect by pruning or polishing. <i>He s got to polish up his French for his job.</i>
polished	To trim and smooth. <i>He was polished and charming.</i>
radiance	A glowing quality of the skin, especially as indicative of good health or youth. <i>The radiance of the sunset dwindled and died.</i>
radiant	Of an appliance designed to emit radiant energy especially for cooking or heating. <i>I sat down by my hissing gas fire one of the radiants was missing.</i>
sheen	The visual property of something that shines with reflected light. <i>Her black hair sheened in the sun.</i>

shine	Make a surface shine. <i>My hair has lost its shine.</i>
shining	Brilliant or excellent at something. <i>Had shining virtues and few faults.</i>
shiny	Having a shiny surface or coating. <i>Saw the moon like a shiny dime on a deep blue velvet carpet.</i>
sleek	Well-groomed and neatly tailored; especially too well-groomed. <i>A sleek black cat.</i>
sparkle	Become bubbly or frothy or foaming. <i>There was a sparkle in his eyes.</i>
sparkling	Shining brightly with flashes of light. <i>Her sparkling blue eyes.</i>
twinkle	Smile so that one's eyes sparkle. <i>Does a constellation twinkle more brightly than a single star.</i>
