## Glue as a Noun

### Definitions of "Glue" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “glue” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *An adhesive substance used for sticking objects or materials together.*
- *Cement consisting of a sticky substance that is used as an adhesive.*



## Synonyms of "Glue" as a noun (6 Words)

**adhesive** A substance used for sticking objects or materials together; glue.  
*Tile **adhesive**.*

**cement** Concrete pavement is sometimes referred to as cement.  
*Dental **cement**.*

**fixative** A liquid sprayed on to a pastel or charcoal drawing to fix colours or prevent smudging.  
*An alcoholic **fixative**.*

**gum** A gum tree especially a eucalyptus.

**mucilage** A gelatinous substance secreted by plants.

**paste** A paste used as an adhesive especially for sticking paper.  
*Blend onions sugar and oil to a **paste**.*

## Glue as a Verb

### Definitions of "Glue" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "glue" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Join or attach with or as if with glue.*
- *Fasten or join with or as if with glue.*
- *Be paying very close attention to (something, especially a television).*
- *Be fixed as if by glue.*



## Synonyms of "Glue" as a verb (8 Words)

<b>be gripped by</b>	To remain unmolested, undisturbed, or uninterrupted — used only in infinitive form.
<b>be hypnotized by</b>	Be identical to; be someone or something.
<b>be mesmerized by</b>	Happen, occur, take place.
<b>be riveted by</b>	Be identical to; be someone or something.
<b>be riveted to</b>	Form or compose.
<b>gum</b>	Cover fill fix or smear with or as if with gum. <i>If you <b>gum</b> the tape it is stronger.</i>
<b>paste</b>	Coat with paste. <i>He <b>pasted</b> his opponent.</i>
<b>stick</b>	Stick to firmly. <i><b>Stick</b> the poster onto the wall.</i>



## Usage Examples of "Glue" as a verb

- *I was glued to the telly when the Olympics were on.*
- *The wood is cut into pieces which are then glued together.*
- *His eyes were glued on her.*



## Associations of "Glue" (30 Words)

- adhere** Be loyal to.  
*Will this wallpaper **adhere** to the wall.*
- adherence** The quality or process of sticking fast to an object or surface.  
***Adherence** to a fat free diet.*
- adhesion** A fibrous band of scar tissue that binds together normally separate anatomical structures.  
*The **adhesion** of the gum strip to the paper.*
- adhesive** Able to stick fast to a surface or object; sticky.  
*An **adhesive** label.*
- attach** Become attached.  
*A good deal of prominence **attaches** to the central union federations.*
- attachment** Temporary secondment to an organization.  
*The processor comes complete with a blender **attachment**.*

<b>chew</b>	Chew food to bite and grind with the teeth. <i>A <b>chew</b> of tobacco.</i>
<b>chomp</b>	Munch or chew noisily or vigorously. <i>The boy <b>chomped</b> his sandwich.</i>
<b>embed</b>	Place (a phrase or clause) within another clause or sentence. <i>The Victorian values <b>embedded</b> in Tennyson's poetry.</i>
<b>epoxy</b>	Glue with epoxy. <i><b>Epoxy</b> the shards.</i>
<b>fix</b>	Decide upon or fix definitely. <i>The company is working on a <b>fix</b> but suggests users consider technical workarounds in the meantime.</i>
<b>glutinous</b>	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i><b>Glutinous</b> mud.</i>
<b>gum</b>	Wood or lumber from any of various gum trees especially the sweet gum. <i>The receipts are <b>gummed</b> into a special book.</i>
<b>implant</b>	Provide someone or something with something by implantation. <i>A silicone breast <b>implant</b>.</i>
<b>incisor</b>	A narrow edged tooth at the front of the mouth adapted for cutting In humans there are four incisors in each jaw.
<b>mastication</b>	Biting and grinding food in your mouth so it becomes soft enough to swallow.
<b>mucous</b>	Of or secreting or covered with or resembling mucus. <i><b>Mucous</b> glands of the intestine.</i>
<b>pitchy</b>	Of the blackest black; similar to the color of jet or coal.
<b>primer</b>	A cap or cylinder containing a compound which responds to friction or an electrical impulse and ignites the charge in a cartridge or explosive. <i>Apply three coats of <b>primer</b>.</i>
<b>slimy</b>	Covered with or resembling slime. <i>Thick <b>slimy</b> mud.</i>
<b>sticker</b>	A short knife with a pointed blade used for piercing or stabbing. <i>Warning <b>stickers</b> on the glass.</i>
<b>sticky</b>	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i>The dough should be moist but not <b>sticky</b>.</i>
<b>tacky</b>	(of glue, paint, or other substances) not fully dry and retaining a slightly sticky feel. <i><b>Tacky</b> varnish.</i>
<b>tape</b>	Fasten or attach with tape. <i>A <b>tape</b> of a radio talk.</i>



<b>taping</b>	A recording made on magnetic tape.
	Something resembling the tooth of an animal.
<b>tooth</b>	<i>The paper used in copying machines is good as it has <b>tooth</b> and takes ink well.</i>
	Remove the tusks of animals.
<b>tusk</b>	<i><b>Tusk</b> an elephant.</i>
	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive.
<b>viscid</b>	<i>The <b>viscid</b> mucus lining of the intestine.</i>
	The state of being thick, sticky, and semi-fluid in consistency, due to internal friction.
<u><a href="#">viscosity</a></u>	<i>Cooling the fluid raises its <b>viscosity</b>.</i>
	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive.
<u><a href="#">viscous</a></u>	<i><b>Viscous</b> lava.</i>
