

## Synonyms of "Gluttony" as a noun (10 Words)

binge eating	An occasion for excessive eating or drinking.
gourmandism	The disposition and habits of a gourmand.
greed	Intense and selfish desire for something, especially wealth, power, or food. The colonists <b>greed</b> for African land.
greediness	An excessive desire for wealth (usually in large amounts. <i>The <b>greediness</b> of lawyers.</i>
gula	Eating to excess (personified as one of the deadly sins.
overconsumption	The action or fact of consuming something to excess. <i>The overconsumption of alcohol.</i>
overeating	Eating to excess (personified as one of the deadly sins. The effect of <b>overeating</b> is weight gain.
voraciousness	Excessive desire to eat.
voracity	Extreme gluttony.
