Definitions of "Gluttony" as a noun

- *Habitual eating to excess.*
- *Eating to excess (personified as one of the deadly sins).*



Synonyms of "Gluttony" as a noun (10 Words)

binge eating	An occasion for excessive eating or drinking.
gourmandism	The disposition and habits of a gourmand.
greed	Intense and selfish desire for something, especially wealth, power, or food. <i>The colonists greed for African land.</i>
greediness	An excessive desire for wealth (usually in large amounts). <i>The greediness of lawyers.</i>
gula	Eating to excess (personified as one of the deadly sins).
overconsumption	The action or fact of consuming something to excess. <i>The overconsumption of alcohol.</i>
overeating	Eating to excess (personified as one of the deadly sins). <i>The effect of overeating is weight gain.</i>
voraciousness	Excessive desire to eat.
voracity	Extreme gluttony.
