## **Gnarl in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

## **Gnarl in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>am gnarling</b>	We <b>are gnarling</b>
You <b>are gnarling</b>	You <b>are gnarling</b>
He/She/It is gnarling	They are gnarling

#### **Gnarl in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have gnarled	We have gnarled
You have gnarled	You have gnarled
He/She/It has gnarled	They have gnarled

### **Gnarl in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been gnarling	We have been gnarling
You <b>have been gnarling</b>	You have been gnarling
He/She/It has been gnarling	They have been gnarling

#### **Gnarl in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>gnarled</b>	We <b>gnarled</b>
You <b>gnarled</b>	You <b>gnarled</b>
He/She/It <b>gnarled</b>	They <b>gnarled</b>

## **Gnarl in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was gnarling	We <b>were gnarling</b>
You <b>were gnarling</b>	You were gnarling
He/She/It was gnarling	They were gnarling

#### **Gnarl in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had gnarled	We had gnarled
You <b>had gnarled</b>	You had gnarled
He/She/It had gnarled	They had gnarled

## **Gnarl in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been gnarling	We had been gnarling
You <b>had been gnarling</b>	You had been gnarling
He/She/It had been gnarling	They had been gnarling

## **Gnarl in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will gnarl</b>	We <b>will gnarl</b>
You <b>will gnarl</b>	You <b>will gnarl</b>
He/She/It will gnarl	They will gnarl

## **Gnarl in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be gnarling	We <b>will be gnarling</b>
You <b>will be gnarling</b>	You <b>will be gnarling</b>
He/She/It will be gnarling	They will be gnarling

He/She/It will have been gnarling	They will have been gnarling
