Associations of "Go with the flow" (30 Words)

aqueduct	A conduit that resembles a bridge but carries water over a valley.
basin	A bowl for washing typically attached to a wall and having taps connected to a water supply a washbasin. <i>The gravel pit is to be used as a yacht basin.</i>
canal	Provide a city with a canal. <i>They travelled on by canal.</i>
canalize	Provide (a city) with a canal. <i>Successive railway engineers were to divert and canalize many miles of river.</i>
channel	A service or station using a channel of frequencies. <i>Meg Ryan plays Avery as if she s channelling Nicole Kidman.</i>
conduit	A person or organization that acts as a channel for the transmission of something. <i>The gas pipe should not be close to any electrical conduit.</i>
confluence	A coming together of people. <i>The confluence of the Rivers Ouse and Foss.</i>
ditch	Provide with a ditch or ditches. <i>He was picked up by a gunboat after ditching his plane in the Mediterranean.</i>
dive	A cheap disreputable nightclub or dance hall. <i>Divers should have a good intake of fluid before each dive.</i>
float	Allow a currency to float. <i>Ice cream floats.</i>
irrigate	Supply with a constant flow or sprinkling of some liquid, for the purpose of cooling, cleansing, or disinfecting. <i>Irrigate the wound.</i>

irrigation	(medicine) cleaning a wound or body organ by flushing or washing out with water or a medicated solution. <i>For sinus congestion saline nasal irrigation can be helpful.</i>
isthmus	A narrow organ, passage, or piece of tissue connecting two larger parts.
navigable	(of a website) easy to move around in. <i>A good cart track navigable by cars.</i>
neap	Of a boat be kept aground or in harbour by a neap tide. <i>Neaps occur at 6 a m and 6 p m.</i>
overflow	Overflow with a certain feeling. <i>Boxes overflowing with bright flowers.</i>
pipeline	Convey a substance by a pipeline. <i>A pipeline runs from the wells to the seaport.</i>
river	A large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea a lake or another river. <i>Great rivers of molten lava.</i>
sea	Used to refer to waves as opposed to calm sea. <i>There was still some sea running.</i>
sedimentary	Produced by the action of water.
strait	Used in reference to a situation characterized by a specified degree of trouble or difficulty. <i>My captivity was strait as ever.</i>
stream	Something that resembles a flowing stream in moving continuously. <i>His nose streamed blood.</i>
surfing	The sport of riding a surfboard toward the shore on the crest of a wave. <i>Why share your internet connection with people surfing and chatting.</i>
swim	The act of swimming. <i>We had to swim for 20 minutes to reach the shore.</i>
teem	Be teeming be abuzz. <i>The plaza is teeming with undercover policemen.</i>
tidal	Relating to or affected by tides. <i>Strong tidal currents.</i>
tide	Of a ship work in or out of harbour with the help of the tide. <i>He drifted into sleep on a tide of euphoria.</i>
water	Supply with water as with channels or ditches or streams. <i>A water plant.</i>
waterway	A navigable body of water. <i>The canal was a very successful commercial waterway.</i>
