almighty	Very great; enormous. <i>I swear by almighty God.</i>
atheist	Someone who denies the existence of god. <i>Atheist leanings.</i>
atheistic	Rejecting any belief in gods. <i>Atheistic scientists.</i>
bible	A book regarded as authoritative in its field.
church	The body of people who attend or belong to a particular local church. <i>The separation of church and state.</i>
deist	Of or relating to deism.
deity	Divine status, quality, or nature. <i>A ruler driven by delusions of deity.</i>
divine	Resulting from divine providence. <i>The divine will.</i>
divinity	White creamy fudge made with egg whites. <i>Christ s divinity.</i>
ecumenism	A movement promoting union between religions (especially between Christian churches).
gentile	Relating to or indicating a nation or clan, especially a gens. <i>Christians refer to themselves as gentiles.</i>
heathen	Relating to heathens. <i>My brother and I were raised as my grandma puts it as heathens.</i>
heavenly	Of heaven; divine. <i>Heavenly constellations.</i>
heresy	A belief that rejects the orthodox tenets of a religion. <i>Huss was burned for heresy.</i>
heretic	A person believing in or practising religious heresy.

heretical	Holding an opinion at odds with what is generally accepted. <i>Heretical beliefs.</i>
holy	Dedicated or consecrated to God or a religious purpose; sacred. <i>Saints and holy men.</i>
irreligious	Indifferent or hostile to religion, or having no religious beliefs. <i>An irreligious man.</i>
liturgy	A religious service conducted according to a liturgy. <i>The Church of England liturgy.</i>
monotheism	The doctrine or belief that there is only one God.
orison	Reverent petition to a deity.
pagan	Relating to pagans or their beliefs. <i>A Muslim majority had to live in close proximity to large communities of Christians and pagans.</i>
pantheon	(antiquity) a temple to all the gods. <i>The deities of the Hindu pantheon.</i>
polytheism	The belief in or worship of more than one god. <i>The polytheism of the ancient Near East.</i>
pray	Address a prayer to God or another deity. <i>After several days of rain we were praying for sun.</i>
religion	A particular system of faith and worship. <i>Ideas about the relationship between science and religion.</i>
religious	A member of a religious order who is bound by vows of poverty and chastity and obedience. <i>Both men were deeply religious and moralistic.</i>
shrine	Enclose in a shrine. <i>A Hindu shrine at which offerings are placed twice a day.</i>
theism	Belief in the existence of a god or gods, specifically of a creator who intervenes in the universe. <i>There are many different forms of theism.</i>
worship	The activity of worshipping. <i>Worship of the Mother Goddess.</i>
