<b>almighty</b>	Very great; enormous. <i>I swear by <b>almighty</b> God.</i>
<a href="#">atheist</a>	Someone who denies the existence of god. <i><b>Atheist</b> leanings.</i>
<b>atheistic</b>	Rejecting any belief in gods. <i><b>Atheistic</b> scientists.</i>
<b>bible</b>	A book regarded as authoritative in its field.
<a href="#">church</a>	The body of people who attend or belong to a particular local church. <i>The separation of <b>church</b> and state.</i>
<b>deist</b>	Of or relating to deism.
<b>deity</b>	Divine status, quality, or nature. <i>A ruler driven by delusions of <b>deity</b>.</i>
<a href="#">divine</a>	Resulting from divine providence. <i>The <b>divine</b> will.</i>
<a href="#">divinity</a>	White creamy fudge made with egg whites. <i>Christ s <b>divinity</b>.</i>
<b>ecumenism</b>	A movement promoting union between religions (especially between Christian churches).
<b>gentile</b>	Relating to or indicating a nation or clan, especially a gens. <i>Christians refer to themselves as <b>gentiles</b>.</i>
<a href="#">heathen</a>	Relating to heathens. <i>My brother and I were raised as my grandma puts it as <b>heathens</b>.</i>
<a href="#">heavenly</a>	Of heaven; divine. <i><b>Heavenly</b> constellations.</i>
<a href="#">heresy</a>	A belief that rejects the orthodox tenets of a religion. <i>Huss was burned for <b>heresy</b>.</i>
<a href="#">heretic</a>	A person believing in or practising religious heresy.

<b>heretical</b>	Holding an opinion at odds with what is generally accepted. <i><b>Heretical</b> beliefs.</i>
<b>holy</b>	Dedicated or consecrated to God or a religious purpose; sacred. <i>Saints and <b>holy</b> men.</i>
<b>irreligious</b>	Indifferent or hostile to religion, or having no religious beliefs. <i>An <b>irreligious</b> man.</i>
<b>liturgy</b>	A religious service conducted according to a liturgy. <i>The Church of England <b>liturgy</b>.</i>
<b>monotheism</b>	The doctrine or belief that there is only one God.
<b>orison</b>	Reverent petition to a deity.
<b>pagan</b>	Relating to pagans or their beliefs. <i>A Muslim majority had to live in close proximity to large communities of Christians and <b>pagans</b>.</i>
<b>pantheon</b>	(antiquity) a temple to all the gods. <i>The deities of the Hindu <b>pantheon</b>.</i>
<b>polytheism</b>	The belief in or worship of more than one god. <i>The <b>polytheism</b> of the ancient Near East.</i>
<b>pray</b>	Address a prayer to God or another deity. <i>After several days of rain we were <b>praying</b> for sun.</i>
<b>religion</b>	A particular system of faith and worship. <i>Ideas about the relationship between science and <b>religion</b>.</i>
<b>religious</b>	A member of a religious order who is bound by vows of poverty and chastity and obedience. <i>Both men were deeply <b>religious</b> and moralistic.</i>
<b>shrine</b>	Enclose in a shrine. <i>A Hindu <b>shrine</b> at which offerings are placed twice a day.</i>
<b>theism</b>	Belief in the existence of a god or gods, specifically of a creator who intervenes in the universe. <i>There are many different forms of <b>theism</b>.</i>
<b>worship</b>	The activity of worshipping. <i><b>Worship</b> of the Mother Goddess.</i>
