The **heresy** of being uncommitted to the right political dogma.

**heretic** A person holding an opinion at odds with what is generally accepted.

heretical Believing in or practising religious heresy.

Heretical beliefs.

heterodox Not conforming with accepted or orthodox standards or beliefs.

**Heterodox** views.

**holy** Used in exclamations of surprise or dismay.

I do not lead a holy life.

idol Someone who is adored blindly and excessively.

A soccer **idol**.

infidel Adhering to a religion other than that of the majority.

A crusade against **infidel**s and heretics.

irreligious Hostile or indifferent to religion.

An **irreligious** man.

liturgy A religious service conducted according to a liturgy.

At the conclusion of the **liturgy** the Bishop presented the certificates.

**monotheism** The doctrine or belief that there is only one God.

**orison** A prayer.

Relating to pagans or their beliefs.

pagan A pagan god.

pantheon A group of particularly respected, famous, or important people.

The **pantheon** of the all time greats.

**Pray** to the Lord.
