Associations of "God dammit" (30 Words)

almighty	A name or title for God. <i>The silence was broken by an almighty roar.</i>
<u>atheist</u>	Someone who denies the existence of god. <i>Atheist leanings.</i>
atheistic	Rejecting any belief in gods. <i>Some were preoccupied with God others were atheistic to the core.</i>
<u>church</u>	Take a woman who has recently given birth to church for a service of thanksgiving. <i>Church a woman after childbirth.</i>
deist	A person who believes that God created the universe and then abandoned it.
deity	A god or goddess (in a polytheistic religion). <i>A ruler driven by delusions of deity.</i>
<u>divine</u>	Resulting from divine providence. <i>Divine worship.</i>
<u>divinity</u>	Any supernatural being worshipped as controlling some part of the world or some aspect of life or who is the personification of a force. <i>Ancient Egyptians believed in the divinity of the Pharaohs.</i>
ecumenism	The doctrine of the ecumenical movement that promotes cooperation and better understanding among different religious denominations: aimed at universal Christian unity.
gentile	A Christian. <i>Christians refer to themselves as gentiles.</i>
<u>heathen</u>	Relating to heathens. <i>Heathen practices.</i>
<u>heavenly</u>	Of or relating to the sky. <i>A heavenly body.</i>

heresy	Opinion profoundly at odds with what is generally accepted. <i>The heresy of being uncommitted to the right political dogma.</i>
heretic	A person holding an opinion at odds with what is generally accepted.
heretical	Believing in or practising religious heresy. <i>Heretical beliefs.</i>
heterodox	Not conforming with accepted or orthodox standards or beliefs. <i>Heterodox views.</i>
holy	Used in exclamations of surprise or dismay. <i>I do not lead a holy life.</i>
idol	Someone who is adored blindly and excessively. <i>A soccer idol.</i>
infidel	Adhering to a religion other than that of the majority. <i>A crusade against infidels and heretics.</i>
irreligious	Hostile or indifferent to religion. <i>An irreligious man.</i>
liturgy	A religious service conducted according to a liturgy. <i>At the conclusion of the liturgy the Bishop presented the certificates.</i>
monotheism	The doctrine or belief that there is only one God.
orison	A prayer.
pagan	Relating to pagans or their beliefs. <i>A pagan god.</i>
pantheon	A group of particularly respected, famous, or important people. <i>The pantheon of the all time greats.</i>
pray	Address a deity a prophet a saint or an object of worship say a prayer. <i>Pray to the Lord.</i>
religion	The belief in and worship of a superhuman controlling power, especially a personal God or gods. <i>He was raised in the Baptist religion.</i>
religious	A member of a religious order who is bound by vows of poverty and chastity and obedience. <i>I have a religious aversion to reading manuals.</i>
theism	The doctrine or belief in the existence of a God or gods. <i>There are many different forms of theism.</i>
worship	The activity of worshipping. <i>Worship of the Mother Goddess.</i>
