## Associations of "God dammit" (30 Words)

<b>almighty</b>	A name or title for God. <i>The silence was broken by an <b>almighty</b> roar.</i>
<b><u>atheist</u></b>	Someone who denies the existence of god. <i><b>Atheist</b> leanings.</i>
<b>atheistic</b>	Rejecting any belief in gods. <i>Some were preoccupied with God others were <b>atheistic</b> to the core.</i>
<b><u>church</u></b>	Take a woman who has recently given birth to church for a service of thanksgiving. <i><b>Church</b> a woman after childbirth.</i>
<b>deist</b>	A person who believes that God created the universe and then abandoned it.
<b>deity</b>	A god or goddess (in a polytheistic religion). <i>A ruler driven by delusions of <b>deity</b>.</i>
<b><u>divine</u></b>	Resulting from divine providence. <i><b>Divine</b> worship.</i>
<b><u>divinity</u></b>	Any supernatural being worshipped as controlling some part of the world or some aspect of life or who is the personification of a force. <i>Ancient Egyptians believed in the <b>divinity</b> of the Pharaohs.</i>
<b>ecumenism</b>	The doctrine of the ecumenical movement that promotes cooperation and better understanding among different religious denominations: aimed at universal Christian unity.
<b>gentile</b>	A Christian. <i>Christians refer to themselves as <b>gentiles</b>.</i>
<b><u>heathen</u></b>	Relating to heathens. <i><b>Heathen</b> practices.</i>
<b><u>heavenly</u></b>	Of or relating to the sky. <i>A <b>heavenly</b> body.</i>

<a href="#">heresy</a>	Opinion profoundly at odds with what is generally accepted. <i>The <b>heresy</b> of being uncommitted to the right political dogma.</i>
<a href="#">heretic</a>	A person holding an opinion at odds with what is generally accepted.
<b>heretical</b>	Believing in or practising religious heresy. <i><b>Heretical</b> beliefs.</i>
<b>heterodox</b>	Not conforming with accepted or orthodox standards or beliefs. <i><b>Heterodox</b> views.</i>
<b>holy</b>	Used in exclamations of surprise or dismay. <i>I do not lead a <b>holy</b> life.</i>
<a href="#">idol</a>	Someone who is adored blindly and excessively. <i>A soccer <b>idol</b>.</i>
<b>infidel</b>	Adhering to a religion other than that of the majority. <i>A crusade against <b>infidels</b> and heretics.</i>
<b>irreligious</b>	Hostile or indifferent to religion. <i>An <b>irreligious</b> man.</i>
<b>liturgy</b>	A religious service conducted according to a liturgy. <i>At the conclusion of the <b>liturgy</b> the Bishop presented the certificates.</i>
<b>monotheism</b>	The doctrine or belief that there is only one God.
<b>orison</b>	A prayer.
<b>pagan</b>	Relating to pagans or their beliefs. <i>A <b>pagan</b> god.</i>
<b>pantheon</b>	A group of particularly respected, famous, or important people. <i>The <b>pantheon</b> of the all time greats.</i>
<a href="#">pray</a>	Address a deity a prophet a saint or an object of worship say a prayer. <i><b>Pray</b> to the Lord.</i>
<b>religion</b>	The belief in and worship of a superhuman controlling power, especially a personal God or gods. <i>He was raised in the Baptist <b>religion</b>.</i>
<b>religious</b>	A member of a religious order who is bound by vows of poverty and chastity and obedience. <i>I have a <b>religious</b> aversion to reading manuals.</i>
<b>theism</b>	The doctrine or belief in the existence of a God or gods. <i>There are many different forms of <b>theism</b>.</i>
