Associations of "God willing" (30 Words)

atheist	A person who disbelieves or lacks belief in the existence of God or gods. <i>He is a committed atheist.</i>
atheistic	Rejecting any belief in gods. <i>Some were preoccupied with God others were atheistic to the core.</i>
bible	A book regarded as authoritative in its field.
church	Take a woman who has recently given birth to church for a service of thanksgiving. <i>Some people go to church every Sunday.</i>
deist	Of or relating to deism.
deity	The creator and supreme being (in a monotheistic religion such as Christianity). <i>A ruler driven by delusions of deity.</i>
divine	Resulting from divine providence. <i>The divine Shakespeare.</i>
divinity	God. <i>Christ s divinity.</i>
ecumenism	A movement promoting union between religions (especially between Christian churches).
heavenly	Of or belonging to heaven or god. <i>Their shampoos smell heavenly.</i>
heretic	A person who holds unorthodox opinions in any field (not merely religion).
heretical	Holding an opinion at odds with what is generally accepted. <i>I feel a bit heretical saying this but I think the film has too much action.</i>
holy	Belonging to or derived from or associated with a divine power. <i>The holy month of Ramadan.</i>
infidel	Adhering to a religion other than that of the majority. <i>The infidel foe.</i>

liturgy	A religious service conducted according to a liturgy. <i>At the conclusion of the liturgy the Bishop presented the certificates.</i>
oblation	The act of offering the bread and wine of the Eucharist. <i>Oblations for aid to the poor.</i>
omniscience	The state of being omniscient; having infinite knowledge. <i>The notion of divine omniscience.</i>
orison	Reverent petition to a deity.
pagan	Relating to pagans or their beliefs. <i>A pagan god.</i>
pantheon	A building in which the illustrious dead of a nation are buried or honoured. <i>The pantheon of the all time greats.</i>
paradise	The abode of righteous souls after death. <i>My idea of paradise is to relax on the seafront.</i>
pilgrimage	Go on a pilgrimage. <i>Now is the thirty first year of my dark pilgrimage on this earth.</i>
polytheism	Belief in multiple Gods. <i>The polytheism of the ancient Near East.</i>
pray	Address a prayer to God or another deity. <i>I prayed that James wouldn't notice.</i>
religion	A pursuit or interest followed with great devotion. <i>He was raised in the Baptist religion.</i>
religious	A member of a religious order who is bound by vows of poverty and chastity and obedience. <i>Religious in observing the rules of health.</i>
sacrifice	Offer or kill as a religious sacrifice. <i>They offer sacrifices to the spirits.</i>
saintly	Marked by utter benignity; resembling or befitting an angel or saint. <i>A truly saintly woman.</i>
theism	The doctrine or belief in the existence of a God or gods. <i>There are many different forms of theism.</i>
worship	The activity of worshipping. <i>Ancestor worship.</i>
