## Associations of "God willing" (30 Words)

<a href="#">atheist</a>	A person who disbelieves or lacks belief in the existence of God or gods. <i>He is a committed <b>atheist</b>.</i>
<b>atheistic</b>	Rejecting any belief in gods. <i>Some were preoccupied with God others were <b>atheistic</b> to the core.</i>
<b>bible</b>	A book regarded as authoritative in its field.
<a href="#">church</a>	Take a woman who has recently given birth to church for a service of thanksgiving. <i>Some people go to <b>church</b> every Sunday.</i>
<b>deist</b>	Of or relating to deism.
<b>deity</b>	The creator and supreme being (in a monotheistic religion such as Christianity). <i>A ruler driven by delusions of <b>deity</b>.</i>
<a href="#">divine</a>	Resulting from divine providence. <i>The <b>divine</b> Shakespeare.</i>
<a href="#">divinity</a>	God. <i>Christ s <b>divinity</b>.</i>
<b>ecumenism</b>	A movement promoting union between religions (especially between Christian churches).
<a href="#">heavenly</a>	Of or belonging to heaven or god. <i>Their shampoos smell <b>heavenly</b>.</i>
<a href="#">heretic</a>	A person who holds unorthodox opinions in any field (not merely religion).
<b>heretical</b>	Holding an opinion at odds with what is generally accepted. <i>I feel a bit <b>heretical</b> saying this but I think the film has too much action.</i>
<b>holy</b>	Belonging to or derived from or associated with a divine power. <i>The <b>holy</b> month of Ramadan.</i>
<b>infidel</b>	Adhering to a religion other than that of the majority. <i>The <b>infidel</b> foe.</i>

<b>liturgy</b>	A religious service conducted according to a liturgy. <i>At the conclusion of the <b>liturgy</b> the Bishop presented the certificates.</i>
<b>oblation</b>	The act of offering the bread and wine of the Eucharist. <i><b>Oblations</b> for aid to the poor.</i>
<b>omniscience</b>	The state of being omniscient; having infinite knowledge. <i>The notion of divine <b>omniscience</b>.</i>
<b>orison</b>	Reverent petition to a deity.
<b>pagan</b>	Relating to pagans or their beliefs. <i>A <b>pagan</b> god.</i>
<b>pantheon</b>	A building in which the illustrious dead of a nation are buried or honoured. <i>The <b>pantheon</b> of the all time greats.</i>
<b>paradise</b>	The abode of righteous souls after death. <i>My idea of <b>paradise</b> is to relax on the seafront.</i>
<b>pilgrimage</b>	Go on a pilgrimage. <i>Now is the thirty first year of my dark <b>pilgrimage</b> on this earth.</i>
<b>polytheism</b>	Belief in multiple Gods. <i>The <b>polytheism</b> of the ancient Near East.</i>
<b>pray</b>	Address a prayer to God or another deity. <i>I <b>prayed</b> that James wouldn't notice.</i>
<b>religion</b>	A pursuit or interest followed with great devotion. <i>He was raised in the Baptist <b>religion</b>.</i>
<b>religious</b>	A member of a religious order who is bound by vows of poverty and chastity and obedience. <i><b>Religious</b> in observing the rules of health.</i>
<b>sacrifice</b>	Offer or kill as a religious sacrifice. <i>They offer <b>sacrifices</b> to the spirits.</i>
<b>saintly</b>	Marked by utter benignity; resembling or befitting an angel or saint. <i>A truly <b>saintly</b> woman.</i>
<b>theism</b>	The doctrine or belief in the existence of a God or gods. <i>There are many different forms of <b>theism</b>.</i>
<b>worship</b>	The activity of worshipping. <i>Ancestor <b>worship</b>.</i>
