Definitions of "Godlike" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “godlike” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Being or having the nature of a god.*
- *Resembling God or a god in qualities such as power, beauty, or benevolence.*
- *Befitting a god.*
- *Being or having the nature of a god-J.G.Frazier-J.G.Saxe.*
- *Appropriate to or befitting a god-R.H.Roveref.*
- *Appropriate to or befitting a god.*

Synonyms of "Godlike" as an adjective (6 Words)

<u>angelic</u>	Marked by utter benignity; resembling or befitting an angel or saint. <i>She looks remarkably young and angelic.</i>
<u>divine</u>	Resulting from divine providence. <i>Divine guidance.</i>
godly	Emanating from God-Saturday Review. <i>A godly man.</i>
seraphic	Of or relating to an angel of the first order. <i>He imagined a seraphic presence in the room.</i>

superhuman Above or beyond the human or demanding more than human power or endurance.
*The pilot made one last **superhuman** effort not to come down right on our heads.*

transcendent (of God) existing apart from and not subject to the limitations of the material universe.
*The notion of any **transcendent** reality beyond thought.*

Usage Examples of "Godlike" as an adjective

- *Man must play God for he has acquired certain godlike powers.*
- *Our parents are godlike figures to our childish eyes.*
- *A man of godlike sagacity.*
- *He is a noble figure of godlike magnanimity.*
