### **Definitions of "Goo" as a noun**

- *Any thick, viscous matter.*
- *A sticky or slimy substance.*
- *Excessive sentimentality.*



## Synonyms of "Goo" as a noun (14 Words)

- emotionalism** Emotional nature or quality.
- goop** Any thick, viscous matter.
- guck** A slimy, dirty, or otherwise unpleasant substance.  
*He got mud and cow **guck** all over his white jersey.*
- gunk** An unpleasantly sticky or messy substance.  
*Factories spewing out unspeakable **gunk**.*
- mawkishness** Insincere pathos.
- muck** Fecal matter of animals.  
*I ll just clean the **muck** off the windscreen.*
- ooze** Any thick, viscous matter.  
*I picked a fruit and watched the **ooze** of fig milk from the stem.*

**sentimentalism** Excessively sentimental behaviour, writing, or speech.  
*The author blends realism with surrealism journalism with **sentimentalism**.*

**sentimentality** Falsely emotional in a maudlin way.  
*There are passages which verge on **sentimentality**.*

**slime** Any thick, viscous matter.  
*The cold stone was wet with **slime**.*

**sludge** Thick, soft, wet mud or a similar viscous mixture of liquid and solid components, especially the product of an industrial or refining process.  
*Miscellaneous chemicals and treated **sludges**.*

**slush** Watery mud.  
*The snow was turning into brown **slush** in the gutters.*

**stickiness** The property of sticking to a surface.
