Definitions of "Goo" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “goo” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Any thick, viscous matter.*
- *A sticky or slimy substance.*
- *Excessive sentimentality.*



Synonyms of "Goo" as a noun (14 Words)

emotionalism	Emotional nature or quality.
goop	Any thick, viscous matter.
guck	A slimy, dirty, or otherwise unpleasant substance. <i>He got mud and cow guck all over his white jersey.</i>
gunk	An unpleasantly sticky or messy substance. <i>Factories spewing out unspeakable gunk.</i>
mawkishness	Insincere pathos.
muck	Fecal matter of animals. <i>I ll just clean the muck off the windscreen.</i>
ooze	Any thick, viscous matter. <i>I picked a fruit and watched the ooze of fig milk from the stem.</i>

sentimentalism	Excessively sentimental behaviour, writing, or speech. <i>The author blends realism with surrealism journalism with sentimentalism.</i>
sentimentality	Falsely emotional in a maudlin way. <i>There are passages which verge on sentimentality.</i>
<u>slime</u>	Any thick, viscous matter. <i>The cold stone was wet with slime.</i>
sludge	Thick, soft, wet mud or a similar viscous mixture of liquid and solid components, especially the product of an industrial or refining process. <i>Miscellaneous chemicals and treated sludges.</i>
slush	Watery mud. <i>The snow was turning into brown slush in the gutters.</i>
stickiness	The property of sticking to a surface.
