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
Goods as a Noun

Definitions of "Goods" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "goods" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- Things to be transported, as distinct from passengers.
- The genuine article.
- Merchandise or possessions.





Synonyms of "Goods" as a noun (24 Words)

accoutrements Clothing that is worn or carried, but not part of your main clothing.

appurtenances A supplementary component that improves capability.

articles One of a class of artifacts. *An article of clothing.*

Goods carried by a large vehicle.

cargo A cargo of oil.

chattels Personal as opposed to real property; any tangible movable

property (furniture or domestic animals or a car etc.

commodities Articles of commerce.

Property of a personal character that is portable but not used in
