- *Things to be transported, as distinct from passengers.*
- *The genuine article.*
- *Merchandise or possessions.*



## Synonyms of "Goods" as a noun (24 Words)

<b>accoutrements</b>	Clothing that is worn or carried, but not part of your main clothing.
<b>appurtenances</b>	A supplementary component that improves capability.
<b>articles</b>	One of a class of artifacts. <i>An article of clothing.</i>
<b>cargo</b>	Goods carried by a large vehicle. <i>A <b>cargo</b> of oil.</i>
<b>chattels</b>	Personal as opposed to real property; any tangible movable property (furniture or domestic animals or a car etc.)
<b>commodities</b>	Articles of commerce.
<b>effects</b>	Property of a personal character that is portable but not used in business. <i>She left some of her personal <b>effects</b> in the house.</i>

<b>freight</b>	A charge for transport by freight. <i>The truck based system can outperform air <b>freight</b> at distances of up to seven hundred miles.</i>
<b>goods and chattels</b>	Personal as opposed to real property; any tangible movable property (furniture or domestic animals or a car etc.)
<b>line</b>	Each of usually five horizontal lines forming a stave in musical notation. <i>There are six <b>lines</b> in every stanza.</i>
<b>lot</b>	The choice resulting from deciding something by lot. <i>A <b>lot</b> of money.</i>
<b>merchandise</b>	Goods to be bought and sold. <i>Good business depends on having good <b>merchandise</b>.</i>
<b><u>paraphernalia</u></b>	Miscellaneous articles, especially the equipment needed for a particular activity. <i>The rituals and <b>paraphernalia</b> of government.</i>
<b>personal effects</b>	A short newspaper article about a particular person or group.
<b>personal possessions</b>	A short newspaper article about a particular person or group.
<b>possessions</b>	(sport) the act of controlling the ball (or puck). <i>They took possession of the ball on their own goal line.</i>
<b>produce</b>	Fresh fruits and vegetable grown for the market. <i>The work was in some degree the <b>produce</b> of their joint efforts.</i>
<b>products</b>	The set of elements common to two or more sets. <i>That store offers a variety of <b>products</b>.</i>
<b>property</b>	Shares or investments in property. <i>The <b>property</b> of heat to expand metal at uniform rates.</i>
<b>solutions</b>	A homogeneous mixture of two or more substances; frequently (but not necessarily) a liquid solution. <i>They were trying to find a peaceful solution.</i>
<b><u>stock</u></b>	Farm animals such as cattle pigs and sheep bred and kept for their meat or milk livestock. <i>The value of his <b>stocks</b> doubled during the past year.</i>
<b>trappings</b>	The outward signs, features, or objects associated with a particular situation, role, or job. <i>I had the <b>trappings</b> of success.</i>
<b>valuables</b>	Something of value. <i>All our <b>valuables</b> were stolen.</i>

**wares**

Articles of the same kind or material; usually used in combination: `silverware', `software.

- *A means of transporting passengers as well as goods.*
- *The market price of an agricultural good.*
