- *Things to be transported, as distinct from passengers.*
- *The genuine article.*
- *Merchandise or possessions.*



Synonyms of "Goods" as a noun (24 Words)

accoutrements	Clothing that is worn or carried, but not part of your main clothing.
appurtenances	A supplementary component that improves capability.
articles	One of a class of artifacts. <i>An article of clothing.</i>
cargo	Goods carried by a large vehicle. <i>A cargo of oil.</i>
chattels	Personal as opposed to real property; any tangible movable property (furniture or domestic animals or a car etc.)
commodities	Articles of commerce.
effects	Property of a personal character that is portable but not used in business. <i>She left some of her personal effects in the house.</i>

freight	A charge for transport by freight. <i>The truck based system can outperform air freight at distances of up to seven hundred miles.</i>
goods and chattels	Personal as opposed to real property; any tangible movable property (furniture or domestic animals or a car etc.)
line	Each of usually five horizontal lines forming a stave in musical notation. <i>There are six lines in every stanza.</i>
lot	The choice resulting from deciding something by lot. <i>A lot of money.</i>
merchandise	Goods to be bought and sold. <i>Good business depends on having good merchandise.</i>
<u>paraphernalia</u>	Miscellaneous articles, especially the equipment needed for a particular activity. <i>The rituals and paraphernalia of government.</i>
personal effects	A short newspaper article about a particular person or group.
personal possessions	A short newspaper article about a particular person or group.
possessions	(sport) the act of controlling the ball (or puck). <i>They took possession of the ball on their own goal line.</i>
produce	Fresh fruits and vegetable grown for the market. <i>The work was in some degree the produce of their joint efforts.</i>
products	The set of elements common to two or more sets. <i>That store offers a variety of products.</i>
property	Shares or investments in property. <i>The property of heat to expand metal at uniform rates.</i>
solutions	A homogeneous mixture of two or more substances; frequently (but not necessarily) a liquid solution. <i>They were trying to find a peaceful solution.</i>
<u>stock</u>	Farm animals such as cattle pigs and sheep bred and kept for their meat or milk livestock. <i>The value of his stocks doubled during the past year.</i>
trappings	The outward signs, features, or objects associated with a particular situation, role, or job. <i>I had the trappings of success.</i>
valuables	Something of value. <i>All our valuables were stolen.</i>

wares

Articles of the same kind or material; usually used in combination: `silverware', `software.



Usage Examples of "Goods" as a noun

- *A means of transporting passengers as well as goods.*
- *The market price of an agricultural good.*
- *The team proved on Friday that they are the goods.*
- *A goods train.*
