Infinitive	to gossip
Present Tense	gossip / gossips
Past Tense	gossiped or gossipped
Present Participle	gossiping or gossipping
Past Participle	gossiped or gossipped

Conjugate Gossip

Gossip in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **gossip** We **gossip**
You **gossip** You **gossip**
He/She/It **gossips** They **gossip**

Gossip in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am gossiping or gossipping** We **are gossiping or gossipping**
You **are gossiping or gossipping** You **are gossiping or gossipping**
He/She/It **is gossiping or gossipping** They **are gossiping or gossipping**

Gossip in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have gossiped or gossipped** We **have gossiped or gossipped**
You **have gossiped or gossipped** You **have gossiped or gossipped**
He/She/It **has gossiped or gossipped** They **have gossiped or gossipped**

Gossip in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been gossiping or gossipping** We **have been gossiping or gossipping**
You **have been gossiping or gossipping** You **have been gossiping or gossipping**
He/She/It **has been gossiping or gossipping** They **have been gossiping or gossipping**

Singular Plural

I **gossiped or gossipped** We **gossiped or gossipped**
You **gossiped or gossipped** You **gossiped or gossipped**
He/She/It **gossiped or gossipped** They **gossiped or gossipped**

Gossip in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I was gossiping or gossipping

You were gossiping or gossipping

He/She/It was gossiping or gossipping

Plural

We were gossiping or gossipping

You were gossiping or gossipping

They were gossiping or gossipping

Gossip in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

I had gossiped or gossipped

You had gossiped or gossipped

He/She/It had gossiped or gossipped

Plural

We had gossiped or gossipped

You had gossiped or gossipped

They had gossiped or gossipped

Gossip in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I had been gossiping or gossipping

You had been gossiping or gossipping

He/She/It had been gossiping or gossipping

Plural

We had been gossiping or gossipping

You had been gossiping or gossipping

They had been gossiping or gossipping

Gossip in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

I will gossip

You will gossip

He/She/It will gossip

Plural

We will gossip

You will gossip

They will gossip

Gossip in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I will be gossiping or gossipping

You will be gossiping or gossipping

He/She/It will be gossiping or gossipping

Plural

We will be gossiping or gossipping

You will be gossiping or gossipping

They will be gossiping or gossipping

Gossip in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

I will have gossiped or gossipped

You will have gossiped or gossipped

He/She/It will have gossiped or gossipped

Plural

We will have gossiped or gossipped

You will have gossiped or gossipped

They will have gossiped or gossipped

Gossip in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I will have been gossiping or gossipping

**You will have been gossiping or
gossipping**

**He/She/It will have been gossiping or
gossipping**

Plural

**We will have been gossiping or
gossipping**

**You will have been gossiping or
gossipping**

**They will have been gossiping or
gossipping**
