Gossip in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Gossip in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have gossiped or gossipped	We have gossiped or gossipped
You have gossiped or gossipped	You have gossiped or gossipped
He/She/It has gossiped or gossipped	I They have gossiped or gossipped

Gossip in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been gossiping or gossipping	We have been gossiping or gossipping
You have been gossiping or gossipping	You have been gossiping or gossipping
He/She/It has been gossiping or gossipping	J They have been gossiping or gossipping

Gossip in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Gossip in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been gossiping or gossipping	We had been gossiping or gossipping

Gossip in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I will gossip	We will gossip
You will gossip	You will gossip
He/She/It will gossip	They will gossip

Gossip in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I will be gossiping or gossipping	We will be gossiping or gossipping
