acquire	Come into the possession of something concrete or abstract. <i>I acquired a strong aversion to television.</i>
acquired	Gotten through environmental forces. <i>Acquired characteristics such as a suntan or a broken nose cannot be passed on.</i>
achievement	An ability that has been acquired by training. <i>The achievement of self control.</i>
acquisition	An asset or object bought or obtained, typically by a library or museum. <i>The child s acquisition of language.</i>
arrive	Reach a destination arrive by movement or progress. <i>The invitation arrived a few days later.</i>
attain	Reach (a specified age, size, or amount). <i>He attained the rank of Brigadier.</i>
attainable	Capable of being attained or accomplished. <i>Choose an attainable goal.</i>
available	Convenient for use or disposal. <i>The list of available candidates is unusually long.</i>
bring	Go or come after and bring or take back. <i>Bring comments.</i>
come	Come forth. <i>He s come a long way.</i>
derive	Arise from or originate in (a specified source). <i>The present name derives from an older form.</i>
earn	Earn on some commercial or business transaction earn as salary or wages. <i>I earned 10 an hour working in the shop.</i>
expulsion	Squeezing out by applying pressure. <i>His expulsion from the union.</i>

fetch	The action of fetching. <i>She fetched me a cup of tea.</i>
gain	Increase the amount or rate of (something, typically weight or speed). <i>She gained 20 pounds when she stopped exercising.</i>
have	Have sex with archaic use. <i>I have two years left.</i>
<u>incur</u>	Receive a specified treatment (abstract). <i>People who smoke incur a great danger to their health.</i>
obtain	Get, acquire, or secure (something). <i>Adequate insurance cover is difficult to obtain.</i>
obtainable	Able to be obtained. <i>Customers financial details are easily obtainable.</i>
possession	The state of being controlled by a demon or spirit. <i>He remains in full possession of his sanity.</i>
procure	Arrange for sexual partners for others. <i>He procured his wife to sign the mandate for the joint account.</i>
<u>procurement</u>	The act of getting possession of something. <i>Financial assistance for the procurement of legal advice.</i>
purchase	Obtain by purchase acquire by means of a financial transaction. <i>The large number of videos currently available for purchase.</i>
reach	A distance traversed in reaching. <i>Denim shorts that reach to his knees.</i>
receive	Receive a specified treatment abstract. <i>Representatives of the club will be received by the Mayor.</i>
recipient	The semantic role of the animate entity that is passively involved in the happening denoted by the verb in the clause. <i>The recipient of the Nobel Peace Prize.</i>
<u>regain</u>	Come upon after searching; find the location of something that was missed or lost. <i>They were unable to regain their boats.</i>
retrieval	The action of obtaining or consulting material stored in a computer system. <i>The investigation was completed after the retrieval of plane wreckage.</i>
<u>secure</u>	Seek to guarantee repayment of (a loan) by having a right to take possession of an asset in the event of non-payment. <i>A secure investment.</i>

Manage to obtain (something) by persuading or cleverly manipulating someone.
