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Associations of "Gotten" (30 Words)

acquire	Take on a certain form, attribute, or aspect. <i>I acquired a passing knowledge of Chinese.</i>
acquired	Gotten through environmental forces. <i>Acquired characteristics such as a suntan or a broken nose cannot be passed on.</i>
acquisition	An ability that has been acquired by training. <i>The acquisition of self control.</i>
acquirement	The act of contracting or assuming or acquiring possession of something. <i>There were many acquisitions among travel agents.</i>
arrive	Reach a destination arrive by movement or progress. <i>He still has to pinch himself to be sure he really has arrived.</i>
attain	Find unexpectedly. <i>He attained the rank of Brigadier.</i>
attainable	Able to be attained; achievable. <i>Choose an attainable goal.</i>
available	Convenient for use or disposal. <i>Kept a fire extinguisher available.</i>
bring	Go or come after and bring or take back. <i>Bring water to the boiling point.</i>
come	Come from be connected by a relationship of blood for example. <i>Come and live with me.</i>
derive	Obtain. <i>Derive pleasure from one s garden.</i>
earn	Earn on some commercial or business transaction earn as salary or wages. <i>This latest win earned them 50 000 in prize money.</i>
expulsion	The act of forcing out someone or something. <i>A rise in the number of pupil expulsions.</i>

fetch	The action of fetching. <i>The devil will fetch you.</i>
gain	The advantageous quality of being beneficial. <i>The process has gained the confidence of the industry.</i>
have	Have put someone at a disadvantage in an argument. <i>Have you got a job yet.</i>
<u>incur</u>	Make oneself subject to; bring upon oneself; become liable to. <i>People who smoke incur a great danger to their health.</i>
obtain	Get, acquire, or secure (something). <i>How did you obtain the visa.</i>
obtainable	Able to be obtained. <i>Customers financial details are easily obtainable.</i>
possession	A territory that is controlled by a ruling state. <i>The landlord wishes to gain possession of the accommodation.</i>
procure	Obtain (someone) as a prostitute for another person. <i>He haunted railway stations to procure young girls for immoral purposes.</i>
<u>procurement</u>	The action or occupation of acquiring military equipment and supplies. <i>Financial assistance for the procurement of legal advice.</i>
purchase	Something acquired by purchase. <i>They closed the purchase with a handshake.</i>
reach	Reach a goal e.g. <i>Unemployment reached a peak in 1933.</i>
receive	Receive a specified treatment abstract. <i>She was not allowed to receive visitors.</i>
recipient	A person or thing that receives or is awarded something. <i>The recipient of the Nobel Peace Prize.</i>
<u>regain</u>	Reach (a place, position, or thing) again; get back to. <i>He soon regained his composure.</i>
retrieval	The operation of accessing information from the computer's memory. <i>My retrieval of people's names is very poor.</i>
<u>secure</u>	Not likely to fail or give way. <i>Check to ensure that all nuts and bolts are secure.</i>
wangle	Manage to obtain (something) by persuading or cleverly manipulating someone. <i>I think we should be able to wangle it so that you can start tomorrow.</i>
