adroit	Clever or skilful. <i>His adroit replies to hecklers won him many followers.</i>
agile	Mentally quick. <i>Agile methods replace high level design with frequent redesign.</i>
deft	Skillful in physical movements; especially of the hands. <i>A deft piece of footwork.</i>
dexterous	Showing or having skill, especially with the hands. <i>Dexterous of hand and inventive of mind.</i>
dignified	Having or expressing dignity; especially formality or stateliness in bearing or appearance. <i>She maintained a dignified silence.</i>
discerning	Having or revealing keen insight and good judgment. <i>A discerning reader.</i>

distinguished	Dignified and noble in appearance or manner. <i>His distinguished bearing.</i>
easy	Achieved without great effort; presenting few difficulties. <i>Easy living.</i>
effortless	Requiring or apparently requiring no effort. <i>I went up the steps in two effortless bounds.</i>
elegant	Refined and tasteful in appearance or behavior or style. <i>An elegant dark suit.</i>
flowing	Graceful and fluent. <i>A flowing prose style.</i>
fluent	Able to flow freely; fluid. <i>He spoke fluent Spanish.</i>
fluid	Characteristic of a fluid capable of flowing and easily changing shape. <i>A fluid situation fraught with uncertainty.</i>
light-footed	Having a light and springy step.
natural	Relating to earthly human or physical nature as distinct from the spiritual or supernatural realm. <i>Natural cliffs.</i>
neat	Without water. <i>Her neat dress.</i>
nimble	Mentally quick. <i>As nimble as a deer.</i>
poised	Marked by balance or equilibrium and readiness for action. <i>A gull in poised flight.</i>
precise	(of a person) exact, accurate, and careful about details. <i>A precise mind.</i>
refined	With impurities or unwanted elements having been removed by processing. <i>To gild refined gold.</i>
smooth	Music without breaks between notes smooth and connected. <i>His face was curiously smooth and youthful.</i>
sophisticated	Appealing to or frequented by people who are sophisticated. <i>A sophisticated audience.</i>
stylish	Having elegance or taste or refinement in manners or dress. <i>A stylish cocktail bar.</i>
supple	(used of persons' bodies) capable of moving or bending freely. <i>This body oil leaves your skin feeling deliciously supple.</i>

tasteful

Having or showing or conforming to good taste.
*A **tasteful** lounge bar.*

with good taste Having the normally expected amount.

aplomb	Self-confidence or assurance, especially when in a demanding situation. <i>Diana passed the test with aplomb.</i>
belle	A beautiful girl or woman, especially the most beautiful at a particular event. <i>The belle of the ball.</i>
benediction	(in the Roman Catholic Church) a service in which the congregation is blessed with the sacrament. <i>He eventually wins benediction.</i>
blessing	The formal act of approving. <i>It s a blessing we re alive.</i>
breakable	An article that is fragile and easily broken. <i>Breakable ornaments.</i>
brittle	A brittle sweet made from nuts and set melted sugar. <i>A brittle and calculating woman.</i>
cultivated	Marked by refinement in taste and manners. <i>He was a remarkably cultivated and educated man.</i>

cultured	Characterized by refined taste and manners and good education. Cultured <i>Bostonians.</i>
dainty	Affectedly dainty or refined. <i>A dainty morsel.</i>
debonair	Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air. <i>A debonair gentleman.</i>
delicate	A delicate fabric or garment. <i>His delicate ball playing skills.</i>
elegance	A refined quality of gracefulness and good taste. <i>The simplicity and elegance of his invention.</i>
elegant	(of a scientific theory or solution to a problem) pleasingly ingenious and simple. <i>An elegant dancer.</i>
enchantingly	In a bewitching manner.
femininity	Qualities or attributes regarded as characteristic of women. <i>She alternated between embracing her femininity and concealing it.</i>
gentility	Elegance by virtue of fineness of manner and expression. <i>Her grandmother's pretensions to gentility.</i>
glorify	Praise glorify or honor. <i>A football video glorifying violence.</i>
grace	In Greek mythology three beautiful goddesses Aglaia Thalia and Euphrosyne believed to personify and bestow charm grace and beauty. <i>A two month grace period.</i>
gracefully	In a gracious or graceful manner. <i>He has aged gracefully.</i>
graciously	In a gracious or graceful manner. <i>He smiled graciously.</i>
luxury	Luxurious or of the nature of a luxury. <i>Luxury goods.</i>
mincing	Affectedly dainty or refined. <i>I don't have to go through the rest of my life with that mincing voice of yours.</i>
poise	Cause to be balanced or suspended. <i>The world was poised between peace and war.</i>
refined	(used of persons and their behavior) cultivated and genteel. <i>Refined people with refined taste.</i>

- sophisticated** Appealing to or frequented by people who are sophisticated.
*A young man with **sophisticated** tastes.*
- svelte** Moving and bending with ease.
*She was **svelte** and sophisticated.*
- tasteful** Having or showing or conforming to good taste.
*A **tasteful** lounge bar.*
- ticklish** (of a person) sensitive to being tickled.
*I m **ticklish** on the feet.*
- urbane** Courteous and refined in manner (typically used of a man).
*The supposedly **urbane** restrained English gentleman.*
- willowy** Bordered, shaded, or covered by willows.
***Willowy** meadow land.*
