<b>adroit</b>	Clever or skilful. <i>His <b>adroit</b> replies to hecklers won him many followers.</i>
<b>agile</b>	Mentally quick. <i><b>Agile</b> methods replace high level design with frequent redesign.</i>
<b>deft</b>	Skillful in physical movements; especially of the hands. <i>A <b>deft</b> piece of footwork.</i>
<b>dexterous</b>	Showing or having skill, especially with the hands. <i><b>Dexterous</b> of hand and inventive of mind.</i>
<b>dignified</b>	Having or expressing dignity; especially formality or stateliness in bearing or appearance. <i>She maintained a <b>dignified</b> silence.</i>
<b>discerning</b>	Having or revealing keen insight and good judgment. <i>A <b>discerning</b> reader.</i>

<b>distinguished</b>	Dignified and noble in appearance or manner. <i>His <b>distinguished</b> bearing.</i>
<b>easy</b>	Achieved without great effort; presenting few difficulties. <i><b>Easy</b> living.</i>
<b>effortless</b>	Requiring or apparently requiring no effort. <i>I went up the steps in two <b>effortless</b> bounds.</i>
<b>elegant</b>	Refined and tasteful in appearance or behavior or style. <i>An <b>elegant</b> dark suit.</i>
<b>flowing</b>	Graceful and fluent. <i>A <b>flowing</b> prose style.</i>
<b>fluent</b>	Able to flow freely; fluid. <i>He spoke <b>fluent</b> Spanish.</i>
<b>fluid</b>	Characteristic of a fluid capable of flowing and easily changing shape. <i>A <b>fluid</b> situation fraught with uncertainty.</i>
<b>light-footed</b>	Having a light and springy step.
<b>natural</b>	Relating to earthly human or physical nature as distinct from the spiritual or supernatural realm. <i><b>Natural</b> cliffs.</i>
<b>neat</b>	Without water. <i>Her <b>neat</b> dress.</i>
<b>nimble</b>	Mentally quick. <i>As <b>nimble</b> as a deer.</i>
<b>poised</b>	Marked by balance or equilibrium and readiness for action. <i>A gull in <b>poised</b> flight.</i>
<b>precise</b>	(of a person) exact, accurate, and careful about details. <i>A <b>precise</b> mind.</i>
<b>refined</b>	With impurities or unwanted elements having been removed by processing. <i>To gild <b>refined</b> gold.</i>
<b>smooth</b>	Music without breaks between notes smooth and connected. <i>His face was curiously <b>smooth</b> and youthful.</i>
<b>sophisticated</b>	Appealing to or frequented by people who are sophisticated. <i>A <b>sophisticated</b> audience.</i>
<b>stylish</b>	Having elegance or taste or refinement in manners or dress. <i>A <b>stylish</b> cocktail bar.</i>
<b>supple</b>	(used of persons' bodies) capable of moving or bending freely. <i>This body oil leaves your skin feeling deliciously <b>supple</b>.</i>

**tasteful**

Having or showing or conforming to good taste.  
*A **tasteful** lounge bar.*

**with good taste** Having the normally expected amount.

## Associations of "Graceful" (30 Words)

<b>aplomb</b>	Self-confidence or assurance, especially when in a demanding situation. <i>Diana passed the test with <b>aplomb</b>.</i>
<b>belle</b>	A beautiful girl or woman, especially the most beautiful at a particular event. <i>The <b>belle</b> of the ball.</i>
<b>benediction</b>	(in the Roman Catholic Church) a service in which the congregation is blessed with the sacrament. <i>He eventually wins <b>benediction</b>.</i>
<b>blessing</b>	The formal act of approving. <i>It s a <b>blessing</b> we re alive.</i>
<b>breakable</b>	An article that is fragile and easily broken. <i><b>Breakable</b> ornaments.</i>
<b>brittle</b>	A brittle sweet made from nuts and set melted sugar. <i>A <b>brittle</b> and calculating woman.</i>
<b>cultivated</b>	Marked by refinement in taste and manners. <i>He was a remarkably <b>cultivated</b> and educated man.</i>

<b>cultured</b>	Characterized by refined taste and manners and good education. <b>Cultured</b> <i>Bostonians.</i>
<b><u>dainty</u></b>	Affectedly dainty or refined. A <b>dainty</b> morsel.
<b>debonair</b>	Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air. A <b>debonair</b> gentleman.
<b>delicate</b>	A delicate fabric or garment. His <b>delicate</b> ball playing skills.
<b>elegance</b>	A refined quality of gracefulness and good taste. The simplicity and <b>elegance</b> of his invention.
<b>elegant</b>	(of a scientific theory or solution to a problem) pleasingly ingenious and simple. An <b>elegant</b> dancer.
<b>enchantingly</b>	In a bewitching manner.
<b><u>femininity</u></b>	Qualities or attributes regarded as characteristic of women. She alternated between embracing her <b>femininity</b> and concealing it.
<b>gentility</b>	Elegance by virtue of fineness of manner and expression. Her grandmother's pretensions to <b>gentility</b> .
<b>glorify</b>	Praise glorify or honor. A football video <b>glorifying</b> violence.
<b><u>grace</u></b>	In Greek mythology three beautiful goddesses Aglaia Thalia and Euphrosyne believed to personify and bestow charm grace and beauty. A two month <b>grace</b> period.
<b>gracefully</b>	In a gracious or graceful manner. He has aged <b>gracefully</b> .
<b>graciously</b>	In a gracious or graceful manner. He smiled <b>graciously</b> .
<b>luxury</b>	Luxurious or of the nature of a luxury. <b>Luxury</b> goods.
<b>mincing</b>	Affectedly dainty or refined. I don't have to go through the rest of my life with that <b>mincing</b> voice of yours.
<b>poise</b>	Cause to be balanced or suspended. The world was <b>poised</b> between peace and war.
<b><u>refined</u></b>	(used of persons and their behavior) cultivated and genteel. <b>Refined</b> people with <b>refined</b> taste.

- sophisticated** Appealing to or frequented by people who are sophisticated.  
*A young man with **sophisticated** tastes.*
- svelte** Moving and bending with ease.  
*She was **svelte** and sophisticated.*
- tasteful** Having or showing or conforming to good taste.  
*A **tasteful** lounge bar.*
- ticklish** (of a person) sensitive to being tickled.  
*I m **ticklish** on the feet.*
- urbane** Courteous and refined in manner (typically used of a man).  
*The supposedly **urbane** restrained English gentleman.*
- willowy** Bordered, shaded, or covered by willows.  
***Willowy** meadow land.*
