## The Forms of Grave

Infinitive	<b>to grave</b>
Present Tense	<b>grave / graves</b>
Past Tense	<b>graved or grove</b>
Present Participle	<b>graving</b>
Past Participle	<b>graved or graven</b>

## Conjugate Grave

### Grave in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>grave</b>	We <b>grave</b>
You <b>grave</b>	You <b>grave</b>
He/She/It <b>graves</b>	They <b>grave</b>

## **Grave in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am graving</b>	We <b>are graving</b>
You <b>are graving</b>	You <b>are graving</b>
He/She/It <b>is graving</b>	They <b>are graving</b>

## **Grave in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have graved or graven</b>	We <b>have graved or graven</b>
You <b>have graved or graven</b>	You <b>have graved or graven</b>
He/She/It <b>has graved or graven</b>	They <b>have graved or graven</b>

## **Grave in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been graving</b>	We <b>have been graving</b>
You <b>have been graving</b>	You <b>have been graving</b>
He/She/It <b>has been graving</b>	They <b>have been graving</b>

## **Grave in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>graved or grove</b>	We <b>graved or grove</b>
You <b>graved or grove</b>	You <b>graved or grove</b>
He/She/It <b>graved or grove</b>	They <b>graved or grove</b>

## **Grave in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was <b>graving</b>	We were <b>graving</b>
You were <b>graving</b>	You were <b>graving</b>
He/She/It was <b>graving</b>	They were <b>graving</b>

**Grave in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had <b>graved or graven</b>	We had <b>graved or graven</b>
You had <b>graved or graven</b>	You had <b>graved or graven</b>
He/She/It had <b>graved or graven</b>	They had <b>graved or graven</b>

**Grave in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been <b>graving</b>	We had been <b>graving</b>
You had been <b>graving</b>	You had been <b>graving</b>
He/She/It had been <b>graving</b>	They had been <b>graving</b>

**Grave in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will <b>grave</b>	We will <b>grave</b>
You will <b>grave</b>	You will <b>grave</b>
He/She/It will <b>grave</b>	They will <b>grave</b>

**Grave in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be <b>graving</b>	We will be <b>graving</b>
You will be <b>graving</b>	You will be <b>graving</b>
He/She/It will be <b>graving</b>	They will be <b>graving</b>

**Grave in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have graved or graven**

**We will have graved or graven**

**You will have graved or graven**

**You will have graved or graven**

**He/She/It will have graved or graven**

**They will have graved or graven**

**Grave in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been graving**

**We will have been graving**

**You will have been graving**

**You will have been graving**

**He/She/It will have been graving**

**They will have been graving**
