# **Conjugate Gripple**

#### **Gripple in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I gripple	We <b>gripple</b>
You <b>gripple</b>	You <b>gripple</b>
He/She/It gripples	They gripple

## **Gripple in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am grippling	We <b>are grippling</b>
You <b>are grippling</b>	You <b>are grippling</b>
He/She/It is grippling	They are grippling

### **Gripple in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have grippled	We have grippled
You <b>have grippled</b>	You have grippled
He/She/It has grippled	They have grippled

## **Gripple in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been grippling	We have been grippling
You <b>have been grippling</b>	You have been grippling
He/She/It has been grippling	They have been grippling

## **Gripple in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I grippled	We <b>grippled</b>
You <b>grippled</b>	You <b>grippled</b>
He/She/It grippled	They <b>grippled</b>

#### **Gripple in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was grippling	We were grippling
You <b>were grippling</b>	You were grippling
He/She/It was grippling	They were grippling

### **Gripple in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had grippled	We had grippled
You <b>had grippled</b>	You had grippled
He/She/It had grippled	They had grippled

### **Gripple in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been grippling	We had been grippling
You <b>had been grippling</b>	You <b>had been grippling</b>
He/She/It had been grippling	They had been grippling

## **Gripple in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will gripple	We <b>will gripple</b>
You <b>will gripple</b>	You <b>will gripple</b>
He/She/It will gripple	They will gripple

## **Gripple in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be grippling	We will be grippling
You <b>will be grippling</b>	You <b>will be grippling</b>
He/She/It will be grippling	They will be grippling
