Grit in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have gritted or grit (nonstandard) We have gritted or grit (nonstandard)

You have gritted or grit (nonstandard) You have gritted or grit (nonstandard)

He/She/It has gritted or grit (nonstandard)

They have gritted or grit (nonstandard)

Grit in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been gritting We have been gritting
You have been gritting You have been gritting
He/She/It has been gritting They have been gritting

Grit in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I gritted or grit (nonstandard) We gritted or grit (nonstandard)
You gritted or grit (nonstandard)
He/She/It gritted or grit (nonstandard) They gritted or grit (nonstandard)



Grit in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I was gritting We were gritting
You were gritting You were gritting
He/She/It was gritting They were gritting

Grit in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had gritted or grit (nonstandard) We had gritted or grit (nonstandard)
You had gritted or grit (nonstandard)
You had gritted or grit (nonstandard)

He/She/It had gritted or grit (nonstandard)

They had gritted or grit (nonstandard)

Grit in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been gritting We had been gritting
You had been gritting You had been gritting
He/She/It had been gritting They had been gritting

Grit in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will grit We will grit
You will grit You will grit
He/She/It will grit They will grit

Grit in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be gritting
You will be gritting
He/She/It will be gritting
They will be gritting
