adorned	Provided with something intended to increase its beauty or distinction.
apparel	Clothing. <i>All the vestments in which they used to apparel their Deities.</i>
attire	Be dressed in clothes of a specified kind. <i>Lady Agatha was attired in an elaborate evening gown.</i>
bachelor	Lead a bachelor s existence. <i>One of the country s most eligible bachelors.</i>
bedeck	Decorate. <i>He led us into a room bedecked with tinsel.</i>
bouquet	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property. <i>We will happily publish the bouquets and brickbats.</i>
bridal	Of or relating to a wedding. <i>Her white bridal gown.</i>
bride	A woman on her wedding day or just before and after the event. <i>The bride and groom left early last night.</i>
bridegroom	A man on his wedding day or just before and after the event.
chiffon	(of a cake or dessert) made with beaten egg to give a light consistency. <i>Chiffon cake.</i>
cloak	A cloakroom. <i>Preparations had taken place under a cloak of secrecy.</i>
decorated	Provided with something intended to increase its beauty or distinction.
decorative	Serving to make something look more attractive; ornamental. <i>A well appointed house with original decorative features.</i>
dowry	An amount of property or money brought by a bride to her husband on their marriage. <i>Elizabeth s dowry was to be 45 000 in diamonds.</i>

dress	Add a dressing to a salad. <i>He dressed up in a suit and tie.</i>
finery	Expensive or ostentatious clothes or decoration. <i>Officers in their blue gold and scarlet finery.</i>
heterosexual	A heterosexual person someone having a sexual orientation to persons of the opposite sex. <i>Heterosexual relationships.</i>
honeymoon	Spend a honeymoon. <i>They plan to honeymoon in Hawai i.</i>
male	Relating to men or the male gender. <i>Male unemployment.</i>
marital	Of or relating to the state of marriage. <i>Marital fidelity.</i>
marriage	A close and intimate union. <i>The marriage of music and dance.</i>
marry	Perform a marriage ceremony. <i>Eric asked me to marry him.</i>
nuptial	Relating to marriage or weddings. <i>Nuptial day.</i>
plume	Deck with a plume. <i>Smoke plumed from the chimneys.</i>
preen	(of a bird) tidy and clean its feathers with its beak. <i>The pigeon preened her feathers.</i>
raiment	Provide with clothes or put clothes on. <i>Ladies clothed in raiment bedecked with jewels.</i>
sandal	A light shoe with either an openwork upper or straps attaching the sole to the foot. <i>They were dressed in open toed sandals.</i>
trim	Adjust the balance of a ship or aircraft by rearranging its cargo or by means of its trim tabs. <i>He trimmed down from twenty two stone to a mere eighteen.</i>
underwear	Clothing worn under other clothes, typically next to the skin.
wedding	A party of people at a wedding.
