paycheck A check issued in payment of wages or salary.

Small employers with a **payroll** of less than 45 000.

redistribute Distribute anew.

Their primary concern was to **redistribute** income from rich to poor.

The distribution of something in a different way, typically to achieve

redistribution greater social equality.

A government land **redistribution** policy.

revenueThe department of the civil service collecting state revenue.

His priority was to raise government **revenue** and to lower expenditure.

sales Income (at invoice values) received for goods and services over some given

period of time.

seller Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money.

The book became the biggest **seller** in the history of royal publishing.

taxation Government income due to taxation.
