bonus	A distribution of profits to holders of an insurance policy. <i>Big Christmas bonuses.</i>
<u>cash</u>	Exchange for cash. A discount for cash .
customs	The place at a port, airport, or frontier where officials check incoming goods, travellers, or luggage. We were through customs with a minimum of formalities.
detestable	Unequivocally detestable. I found the film s violence detestable .
disgusting	Arousing revulsion or strong indignation. I think the decision is disgusting .
dividend	An individual s share of a dividend. Buying a rail pass may still pay dividend s.
<u>earned</u>	Gained or acquired; especially through merit or as a result of effort or action. A well earned reputation for honesty.
earnings	Money obtained in return for labour or services. <i>He claimed damages for loss of earnings.</i>
execrable	Unequivocally detestable- Edmund Burke. <i>Execrable</i> cheap wine.
fee	A payment made to a professional person or to a professional or public body in exchange for advice or services. They were faced with legal fees of 3000.
gain	Rise in rate or price. We gain ed entry to the car in five seconds.
hateful	Arousing, deserving of, or filled with hatred. A hateful thing to do.



<u>income</u>	The financial gain (earned or unearned) accruing over a given period of time. He has a nice home and an adequate income .
loathsome	Causing hatred or disgust; repulsive. A loathsome disease.
nauseating	Causing or able to cause nausea. A nauseating smell.
odious	Unequivocally detestable. <i>Odious</i> hypocrisy.
overpayment	Payment in excess of what is due. <i>He received 20 000 in benefit overpayments.</i>
paycheck	A check issued in payment of wages or salary.
payroll	The total amount of wages paid by a company. Small employers with a payroll of less than 45 000.
redistribute	Distribute anew. Their primary concern was to redistribute income from rich to poor.
redistribution	The distribution of something in a different way, typically to achieve greater social equality. <i>A government land redistribution policy.</i>
<u>revenue</u>	The department of the civil service collecting state revenue. <i>His priority was to raise government</i> revenue <i>and to lower expenditure.</i>
sales	Income (at invoice values) received for goods and services over some given period of time.
<u>seller</u>	Someone who promotes or exchanges goods or services for money. The book became the biggest seller in the history of royal publishing.
taxation	Government income due to taxation. <i>The progressive nature of taxation</i> .
tonnage	A tax imposed on ships that enter the US based on the tonnage of the ship. <i>Road convoys carry more tonnage</i> .
<u>total</u>	Comprising the whole number or amount. My son total ed our new car.
turnover	The ratio of the number of workers that had to be replaced in a given time period to the average number of workers. The team were sitting on their lead and taking care to avoid turnover s.
vat	Place or treat in a vat. A vat of hot tar.



wageA fixed regular payment earned for work or services, typically paid on a
daily or weekly basis.
