initially	At first. <i>Initially he thought the new concept was nonsense.</i>
innovation	The act of starting something for the first time; introducing something new. <i>Technological innovations designed to save energy.</i>
innovative	(of a product, idea, etc.) featuring new methods; advanced and original. <i>Stylistically innovative works.</i>
<u>invention</u>	Creative ability. <i>His powers of invention were rather limited.</i>
<u>inventive</u>	Having the ability to create or design new things or to think originally. <i>Inventive ceramics.</i>
new	Beginning anew and in a transformed way. <i>New cars.</i>
<u>novelty</u>	Denoting an object intended to be amusing as a result of its unusual design. <i>In 1914 air travel was still a novelty.</i>

<u>original</u>	An original creation i e an audio recording from which copies can be made. <i>The house is reputed to be the original of Mansfield Park.</i>
<u>originality</u>	The ability to think independently and creatively. <i>She s a writer of great originality.</i>
prototype	Make a prototype of a product. <i>He is the prototype of good breeding.</i>
start	A turn to be a starter in a game at the beginning. <i>His starting meant that the coach thought he was one of their best linemen.</i>
unabridged	A dictionary that has not been shortened by the omitting terms or definitions; a comprehensive dictionary. <i>An unabridged edition.</i>
