alliterate	Use alliteration as a form of poetry. <i>His first and last names alliterated.</i>
alliteration	The occurrence of the same letter or sound at the beginning of adjacent or closely connected words. <i>The alliteration of sweet birds sang.</i>
antiquated	Old-fashioned or outdated. <i>This antiquated central heating system.</i>
century	A score of a hundred in a sporting event, especially a batsman’s score of a hundred runs in cricket. <i>A century ago most people walked to work.</i>
decade	A period of ten years. <i>A local priest led the mourners in a decade of the rosary.</i>
dozen	An exchange of insults engaged in as a game or ritual among black Americans. <i>She has dozens of admirers.</i>
few	A small elite group. <i>A few more wagons than usual.</i>
fractional	Constituting or comprising a part or fraction of a possible whole or entirety. <i>A fractional share of the vote.</i>
fragmentary	Consisting of small disconnected or incomplete parts. <i>Excavations have revealed fragmentary remains of masonry.</i>
hundred	Being ten more than ninety. <i>Wantage Hundred.</i>
incomplete	Not having all the necessary or appropriate parts. <i>An incomplete account of his life.</i>
least	Used in names of very small animals and plants e g least shrew. <i>That is the least of my concerns.</i>

less	Fewer. <i>No less than 50 people attended.</i>
manor	The landed estate of a lord (including the house on it). <i>The right to mine ores within the manor of Little Langdale.</i>
moiety	One of two (approximately) equal parts. <i>The enzyme removes the sulphate moiety.</i>
nearly	In a close manner. <i>In the absence of anyone more nearly related I was designated next of kin.</i>
nine	One of four playing cards in a deck with nine pips on the face.
part	Come apart. <i>She can't bear to be parted from her daughter again.</i>
partial	Existing only in part; incomplete. <i>A question to which we have only partial answers.</i>
partially	Only in part; to a limited extent. <i>A partially open door.</i>
portion	The allotment of some amount by dividing something. <i>One end of the barn was portioned off for poultry.</i>
quarter	A square charge which covers the top left dexter chief quarter of the field. <i>There were four scores in the opening quarter.</i>
section	Commit someone compulsorily to a psychiatric hospital in accordance with a section of a mental health act. <i>A residential section of the capital.</i>
semi	A semi trailer. <i>She pulled into the path of a semi.</i>
sketchy	Giving only major points; lacking completeness. <i>A sketchy neighbourhood.</i>
some	To some extent quite a lot. <i>That was some party.</i>
ten	One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
total	The whole number or amount of something. <i>The rock star totals his guitar at every concert.</i>
twelve	The cardinal number that is the sum of eleven and one.
unfinished	(of an object) not having been given an attractive surface appearance as the final stage of manufacture. <i>Her last novel is unfinished.</i>
