## Associations of "Half assed" (30 Words)

<b>alliterate</b>	Use alliteration as a form of poetry. <i>His first and last names <b>alliterated</b>.</i>
<b>alliteration</b>	The occurrence of the same letter or sound at the beginning of adjacent or closely connected words. <i>The <b>alliteration</b> of sweet birds sang.</i>
<b>antiquated</b>	Old-fashioned or outdated. <i>This <b>antiquated</b> central heating system.</i>
<b>century</b>	A score of a hundred in a sporting event, especially a batsman’s score of a hundred runs in cricket. <i>A <b>century</b> ago most people walked to work.</i>
<b>decade</b>	A period of ten years. <i>A local priest led the mourners in a <b>decade</b> of the rosary.</i>
<b>dozen</b>	An exchange of insults engaged in as a game or ritual among black Americans. <i>She has <b>dozens</b> of admirers.</i>
<b>few</b>	A small elite group. <i>A <b>few</b> more wagons than usual.</i>
<b>fractional</b>	Constituting or comprising a part or fraction of a possible whole or entirety. <i>A <b>fractional</b> share of the vote.</i>
<b>fragmentary</b>	Consisting of small disconnected or incomplete parts. <i>Excavations have revealed <b>fragmentary</b> remains of masonry.</i>
<b>hundred</b>	Being ten more than ninety. <i>Wantage <b>Hundred</b>.</i>
<b>incomplete</b>	Not having all the necessary or appropriate parts. <i>An <b>incomplete</b> account of his life.</i>
<b>least</b>	Used in names of very small animals and plants e g least shrew. <i>That is the <b>least</b> of my concerns.</i>

<b>less</b>	Fewer. <i>No <b>less</b> than 50 people attended.</i>
<b>manor</b>	The landed estate of a lord (including the house on it). <i>The right to mine ores within the <b>manor</b> of Little Langdale.</i>
<b>moiety</b>	One of two (approximately) equal parts. <i>The enzyme removes the sulphate <b>moiety</b>.</i>
<b>nearly</b>	In a close manner. <i>In the absence of anyone more <b>nearly</b> related I was designated next of kin.</i>
<b>nine</b>	One of four playing cards in a deck with nine pips on the face.
<b>part</b>	Come apart. <i>She can't bear to be <b>parted</b> from her daughter again.</i>
<b>partial</b>	Existing only in part; incomplete. <i>A question to which we have only <b>partial</b> answers.</i>
<b>partially</b>	Only in part; to a limited extent. <i>A <b>partially</b> open door.</i>
<b>portion</b>	The allotment of some amount by dividing something. <i>One end of the barn was <b>portioned</b> off for poultry.</i>
<b>quarter</b>	A square charge which covers the top left dexter chief quarter of the field. <i>There were four scores in the opening <b>quarter</b>.</i>
<b>section</b>	Commit someone compulsorily to a psychiatric hospital in accordance with a section of a mental health act. <i>A residential <b>section</b> of the capital.</i>
<b>semi</b>	A semi trailer. <i>She pulled into the path of a <b>semi</b>.</i>
<b>sketchy</b>	Giving only major points; lacking completeness. <i>A <b>sketchy</b> neighbourhood.</i>
<b>some</b>	To some extent quite a lot. <i>That was <b>some</b> party.</i>
<b>ten</b>	One of four playing cards in a deck with ten pips on the face.
<b>total</b>	The whole number or amount of something. <i>The rock star <b>totals</b> his guitar at every concert.</i>
<b>twelve</b>	The cardinal number that is the sum of eleven and one.
<b>unfinished</b>	(of an object) not having been given an attractive surface appearance as the final stage of manufacture. <i>Her last novel is <b>unfinished</b>.</i>
